This activity invites you to explore similarities and differences between Noah's ark with the ark of the covenant. Read the statements below. Write the letter of the statement in the left circle if it is only true for Noah's ark. Write the letter of the statement in the right circle if it is only true for the ark of the covenant. Write the letter in the section where the circles overlap if it is true for Noah's ark and the ark of the covenant. To find out about Noah's ark, look at Genesis 6:14-22. For information about the ark of the covenant, look at Exodus 25:10-22.
