

Subject: Tabernacle

Age Group: Beginners: 3-5

basic supplies:      

materials: selfhardening clay
· wire (thick)
· spray paint (gold, copper)
· smocks, newspaper
· flour, water, salt, olive oil

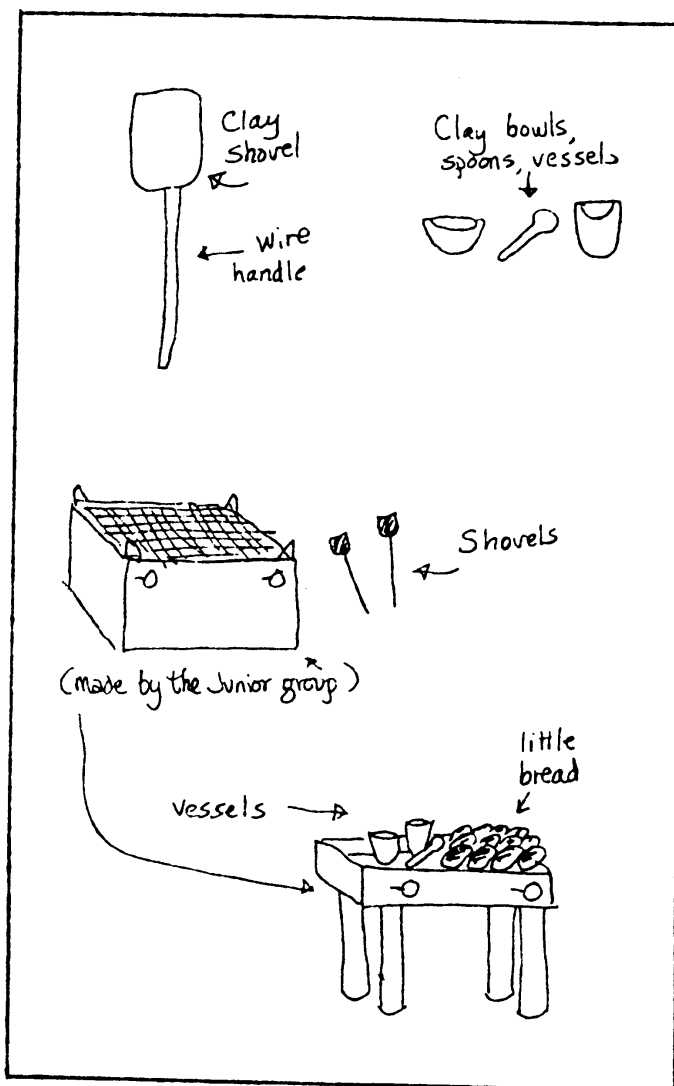
teacher preparation:

· have pictures available (especially the Tabernacle of Israel)

· mix dough for bread: $\frac{1}{2}$ C flour
1 T. ice water
1 T. + 1 tp. oil
 $\frac{1}{4}$ t salt

procedure:

- make shovels for the altar of burnt offering
- make bowls, spoons and vessels for the table of shewbread
- wash hands and make tiny loaves of bread for the table of shewbread - (12 fresh loaves each day!) and bake later
- spray paint when dry - shovels are copper, bowls etc are gold
