

Blue Celery *and* Green Carnations

Materials:

blue and green food coloring
white carnation
celery
glass
water

Procedure: Carnation

1. Take a white carnation and make a fresh cut at the base of the stem.
2. Then put it in a cup filled with water and a few drops of green food coloring.
3. What happens to the carnation? Why?

Procedure: Celery

1. Take a stalk of celery and make a fresh cut at the end (opposite from the end with leaves).
2. Now put it in a glass of water to which you have added a few drops of blue food coloring.
3. What happens?
4. How long does it take for you to see a change?

Concluding Thoughts

This illustrates the way the Lord made plants so that they can take in water.
