Make a picture of a church or an altar.

Think about ways the church helps people.

Make a picture of an angel in heaven.

This is the Lord's wish for you. He wants you to become an angel!

Give us this day our daily bread.

*Make a picture of natural food for the body and spiritual food
for the mind—the Lord's Word.*

**And forgive us our debts
as we also forgive our debtors.**

*Make up an apology from someone who did something unkind to a friend
and write it here. Then write the friend's response: "I forgive you."*

Draw a picture of the friends smiling and shaking hands or hugging.

(If you like, you could write an apology for something that you did wrong.)

And lead us not into temptation,
but deliver us from evil.

Picture 2 guardian angels with a child, keeping him or her safe from evil.

For Thine is the kingdom,

Draw a picture of the Lord in heaven as the King of glory.

Picture Him with a crown and light all around Him.
