basic supplies:

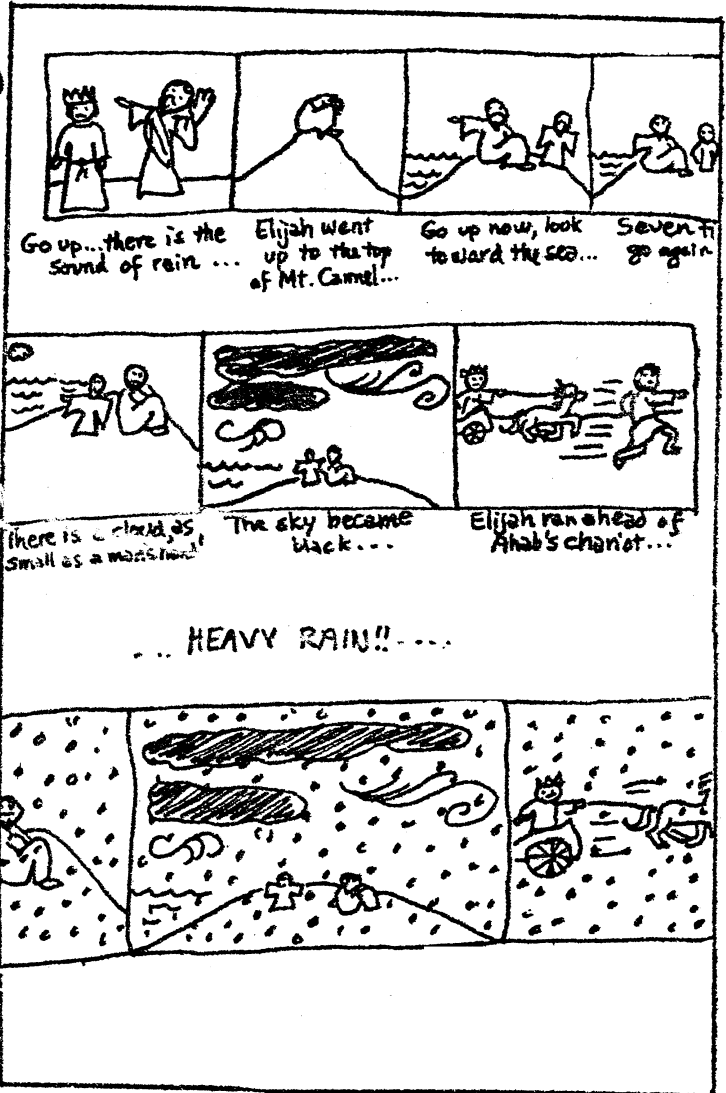


materials:

- crayons not too large, or they will get tired of coloring heavily
- white paper (either individual or mural)
- blue paint, brushes (wide)
- newspapers, smocks

teacher preparation:

- make sample



procedure: lay newspapers, wear smocks

- have each child color one portion of the story when the drought ends
- make sure they cover the whole paper with crayon\*, heavily (or the paint will not resist & look like rain)

when they are all ready, make a "heavy rain"! (paint the whole picture with blue) (maybe make sound effects while you do it!)
