Subject: Asking for a King

basic supplies:



materials: paint

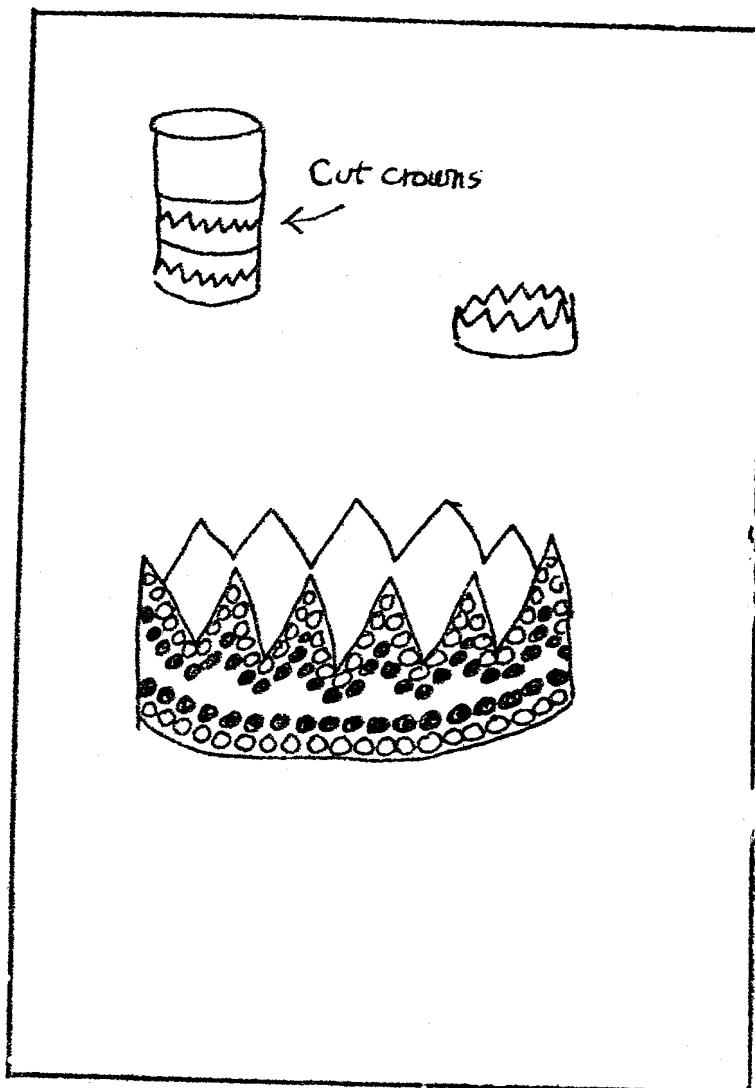
- oatmeal boxes
- hole punchers
- shiny paper (gold, silver, red)
- glue
- egg cartons (optional)
- knife

teacher preparation:

- begin punching little holes from the shiny paper (use compartments of egg carton to separate colors).
- paint oatmeal boxes to cover labels or glue colored paper over it

procedure:

- cut a crown from the oatmeal box
- punch lots of shiny dots (punch several at once)
- glue dots to crown like a mosaic
- encourage children to cover surface of crown (no overlapping, though)



notes: discuss who we want to be our king

- glue should go on crowns, not dots
- tweezers
