basic supplies:



materials: smocks, newspapers

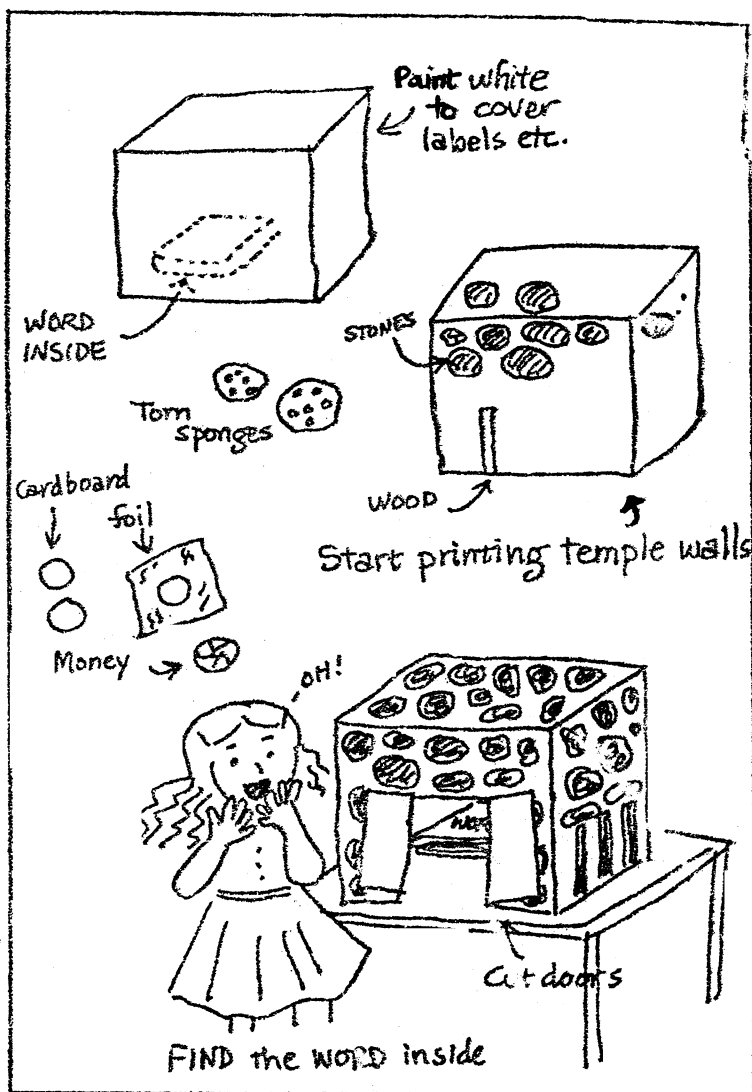
- cardboard box
- grey, white, brown paint, brushes
- sponges
- cardboard
- aluminum foil
- scissors

teacher preparation:

- paint box to cover labels (white) and begin printing stones by dipping torn sponges in paint
- begin painting wooden pillars
- cut cardboard circles (about 1 1/2")
- cut or tear aluminum foil in pieces big enough to cover circles
- put the word hidden inside box

procedure: wear smocks

- children make money by covering cardboard circles with foil
- children pay each other to work on rebuilding the temple, and "buy" stones and wood by trading coins for sponges, paint and brushes
- print stones, paint wooden pillars
- cut doors and... find the LORD'S WORD inside!!
