basic supplies:



materials:

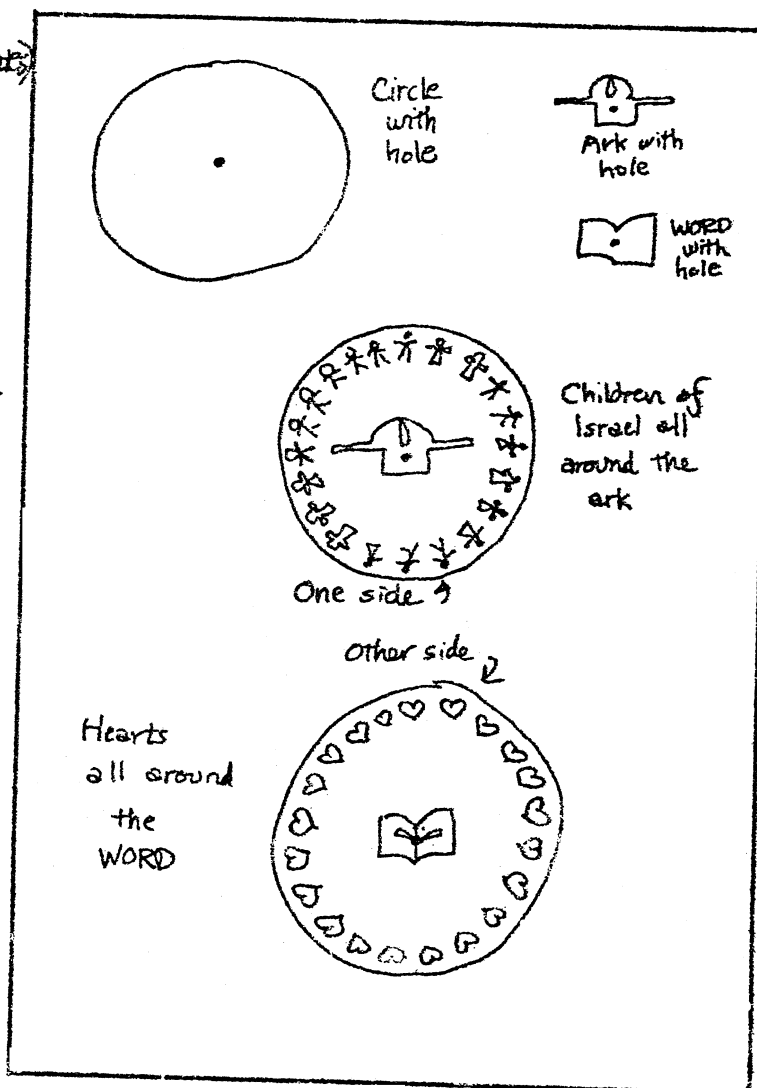
- lots of posterboard; red, white etc (or paper plates)  
(or construction paper and cardboard)
- brass fasteners
- something sharp to poke holes, hole punch
- markers

teacher preparation:

- Cut out circles from posterboard or cardboard covered with construction paper (large is nice, about 18") 1 per child
- Poke holes in centers
- Make sample
- Could draw the ark and WORD for them to cut out, if they are not able to easily

procedure:

- Cut out an ark and the WORD of posterboard or construction paper
- Punch holes in them
- With fastener attach ark to one side and WORD to the other through hole in center of large circle
- Draw Israelites around circumference to represent all Israel having the ark at the center ~ Jerusalem
- On the other side, draw hearts around circumference to represent the WORD at the center of our hearts
- Whenever the children of Israel turn, there is the ark.
- Whenever we turn our hearts, the WORD should be there
