Collect treasures of nature to display near your worship center—perhaps placed around the Word—or as a centerpiece on your kitchen table.

Gather intriguing rocks, leaves, pinecones, flowers, *etc.*, while walking outside with your children.

You could also go to the grocery store and select some interesting vegetables and fruits.

If you have a shell or rock collection, you might want to include a few of these in your display as well.
