basic supplies:



materials:

- musical instruments (piano, guitar, autoharp, triangle, drums, maraca...)
- tape recorder (optional)

teacher preparation:

- Choose possible verses for putting to music ~vivid, easily learned*
 - If you are not a musician, you may want to ask the help of one
- * (retranslate into simple language)
- read introduction of Chapter 13, Vol 3, of Dole's Notes

procedure:

- Using the instruments for accompaniment, invite the children to spontaneously sing your (or other) verses of the psalm.
- This age loves music and will probably surprise you with their ability to put the WORD to music. Try to be as spontaneous as they are, and have fun!
- Tape record the session only if it does not distract the children
