Subject: A Psalm About the Word

Age Group: Junior: 9-11

basic supplies:



materials: felt

- large and small needles, thread, yarn
- white material
- glue, scissors
- big stick or dowel
- red satin blanket binding (optional)
- copies of the psalm

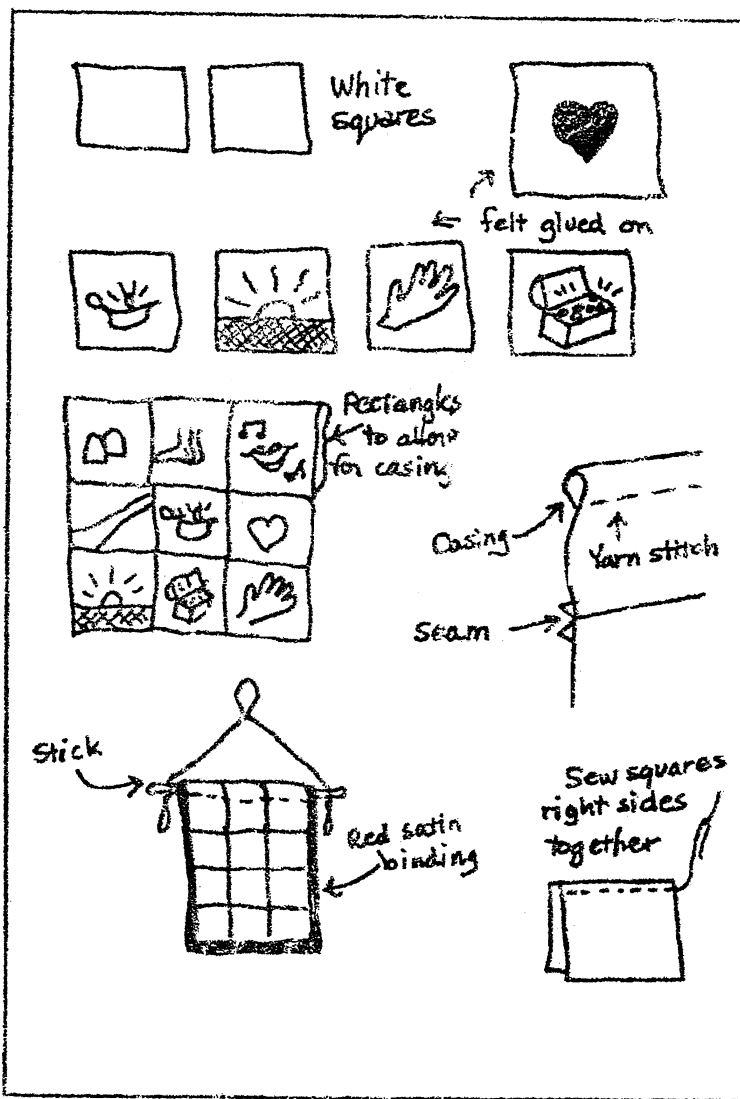
teacher preparation:

- cut white fabric into squares, * descending on number of children
- look through psalm for ideas of images (i.e. verses 2, 19, 32, 35, 43, 48, 54, 59, 103, 105, 136, 162...)

* make top "squares" be rectangles to allow for casing

procedure:

- children pick a simple image to applique on their square(s)
- cut out of felt, glue on (use yarn too, as needed)
- sew squares together with needle and thread
- if desired, sew blanket binding around edge to represent the red cover of the word
- fold over top to form casing and sew with large needle and yarn
- insert big stick and hang banner on yarn



notes: This is meant to be a special, final project of the year
• to simplify, glue on to one big piece of felt and omit squares and sewing
