# I Will Lead Them by a Way They Did Not Know

I will bring the blind by a way they did not know. I will lead them in paths they have not known. I will make the darkness light before them, and crooked places straight (Isaiah 42:16).

Here are two activities families might enjoy doing with one or more children to illustrate these words from Isaiah.

### By a Way they Did Not Know

#### **Materials**

Some kind of special treat (food, game, craft project, *etc.*) Scarf or cloth to use as a blindfold

### **Preparation**

Put the special treat in a place you can reach in a round about way, perhaps going in and out of the house to get there.

#### **Procedure**

- 1. Talk about the activity. It is a way to pretend to be blind and let someone else lead us.
- 2. Use a scarf or cloth to cover the child's eyes.
- 3. Now gently lead the child by an indirect way to the place the surprise is waiting.
- 4. Enjoy the surprise!

## I Will Make Crooked Places Straight

#### Materials

2 long pieces of rope or string OR chalk to use outside on a driveway, sidewalk or parking lot

#### **Procedure**

- 1. Lay a long piece of string on the floor so that it makes a crooked or squiggly path.
- 2. Try walking along it.
- 3. Have another piece of string laid out straight or straighten the squiggly path string.
- 4. Now walk along the straightened path.
- 5. Which is easier to follow?

(Note: Another option is to make the crooked and straight paths by drawing with chalk on a paved surface.)
