Choice Fountains of Living Waters

When the Samaritan woman met the Lord at the well He told her He could give her water that would become a fountain “springing up into everlasting life” (John 4:14). We too can meet the Lord at the “well”. The well corresponds to the Word. Since the Lord *is* the Word, when we learn from the Word we are being taught by Him (see *Divine Providence* 172). The Lord reveals the spiritual meaning of the Word in the Writings for the New Church. These teachings light up and give life to everything in the Word (see *True Christianity* 780). Students will learn about true ideas from the Writings and create a “fountain” of quotations that are a source for everlasting life.

1. The Samaritan woman talked with the Lord when she came to a well for water. Where can we meet and talk to the Lord? (the Word)
2. “The Word” is short for the “Word of God”—in other words, *words God speaks to us*. What is the Word for the New Church? (Old Testament, New Testament, and the Writings)
3. What does each part of the Word tell us? (**Old Testament**: creation, the Lord leading the children of Israel to the promised land; **New Testament**: the Lord coming on earth, teaching, and rising to heaven after death; **Writings**: the hidden meaning of the Old and New Testaments, the reality of life after death, the connection between the spiritual and natural worlds (correspondences), the nature of the Lord and His mission in the world—that His deepest wish is for everyone to go to heaven, marriage love comes from the marriage of true ideas and good loves, marriages can last to eternity)
4. Hand out *The Writings: A Fountain of Living Waters* (pp. 2-3). The left hand column shows true ideas that the Writings explain more fully than ever before. These explanations in the center column are the “new” truths of the “New Church”.
5. With a partner, choose three ideas that interest you. Read the *True Idea*, and *What the Writings Say*. Think about how this idea helps you. For example, “The Lord is love” teaches that although the Lord appeared to be angry in the Old Testament, He was really being loving—just as parents may seem to be angry when they see their children are in danger because they love them. Some people believe that the Lord really is angry because they do not know this true idea. *Optional*: share your ideas with the group.
6. Choose two-four quotations from the column *What the Writings Say*, and write each one on a *Fountain Water Drop* (p. 4). Cut out around the water drops.
7. As a group, share the new truths for the New Church by creating a display of the quotations to illustrate the idea that the Word is a fountain of living waters that will spring up into eternal life. (See picture at top of page.)

optional: blue paper for printing water drops

Prepare in Advance

Find wall space to display the “fountain” of true ideas from the Writings.

The Writings for the New Church give life to everything in the Word. The teachings in the center column are uniquely New Church. Choose three true ideas. Think about how each idea helps you. Write your answers in the final column.

Heaven is in the form of a human being.	<p>The whole heaven resembles one human being, which is therefore called the Greatest Human. <i>Earths in the Universe</i> 9</p>
