

## Jeroboam to Ahab: Eight Evil Kings in Israel

1 Kings 12-1 Kings 16

This review activity briefly looks at the names and deeds of eight evil kings of Israel. After the name of each king, write down some of the evil things he did. The places in the Word where you can find the answers are written under each name. In the last column, write down how many years each king reigned.

<b>Jeroboam</b> (1 Kings 12:28-33, 13:33)		
<b>Nadab</b> (1 Kings 15:25, 26)		
<b>Baasha</b> (1 Kings 15:33, 34)		
<b>Elah</b> (1 Kings 16:13)		
<b>Zimri</b> (Skim 1 Kings 16: 9-19)		
<b>Tibni</b> (no information)		
<b>Omri</b> (1 Kings:23-27)		
<b>Ahab</b> (1 Kings 16:29-33)		

Now create a sentence using the first letter of each word to help you remember the order and names of the kings.
