

## Sort the Wheat and the Tares

We can practice separating good from evil in our lives by weeding out bad thoughts that come into our minds and not putting them into practice in our lives. ### Materials

black paper      yellow or shiny gold paper      scissors      glue  
a copy of the *Wheat and Tares Vocabulary List*

### Instructions

1. Create a single piece of paper out of the black and the shiny gold or yellow paper by taping or gluing the paper together so that the black is on the bottom of the page and the gold is on the top of the page.
2. Cut apart the *Wheat and Tares Vocabulary List* at the bottom of this page. Divide the words into two piles, separating good (heavenly) words from selfish (evil) words.
3. Glue the heavenly words (wheat) to the gold paper at the top of the page. Glue the selfish words (tares) to the black paper at the bottom of the page.
