THE HEALING POWER OF FIGS

2 Kings 20, 21:1-9, 18-24

Figs are mentioned many times in the Word. For example, Hezekiah had a boil that was miraculously healed with a lump of figs. Figs have natural healing powers. For instance, they can act as an antibiotic and help to reduce inflammation and pain. They can also be used to disinfect wounds. Figs have also been used to ease coughs and bronchitis. In Hezekiah's case, figs were not only miraclously healed a boil, but acted quickly.

People used fig trees and their fruit for a variety of purposes such as food, shade, gifts, even clothing. Look up the verses listed in the chart below. On the chart, note what part of the fig tree was used and what it was used for (may be more than one use.)

We can understand the healing powers of the fig tree and its fruit even better when we learn of its spiritual significance.

From these things it is evident that the fig-tree, in the genuine sense, signifies the natural person as to good and truth, the fig itself as a tree, the natural person; the fig as a fruit, the good of the natural person; and its leaf, the truth of that good.
