
Ahab and Ben-Hadad Story Line

2nd: Ben-Hadad asked for Ahab's silver, gold, wives and children. 3rd: Ben-Hadad would take whatever he wanted. 4th: The elders refused to agree to Ben-Hadad's request. 5th: Ben-Hadad threatened Israel. 6th: A prophet appeared saying the Lord would deliver Ben-Hadad to Israel. 7th: Ahab killed the Assyrians. 8th: The prophet told Ahab to prepare for a spring attack in the plains. 9th: Israel prepared for battle. 10th: Israel won the battle. 11th: Assyria agreed to restore cities it had taken and to let Israel trade.
