basic supplies:



materials: paper (long & thin)

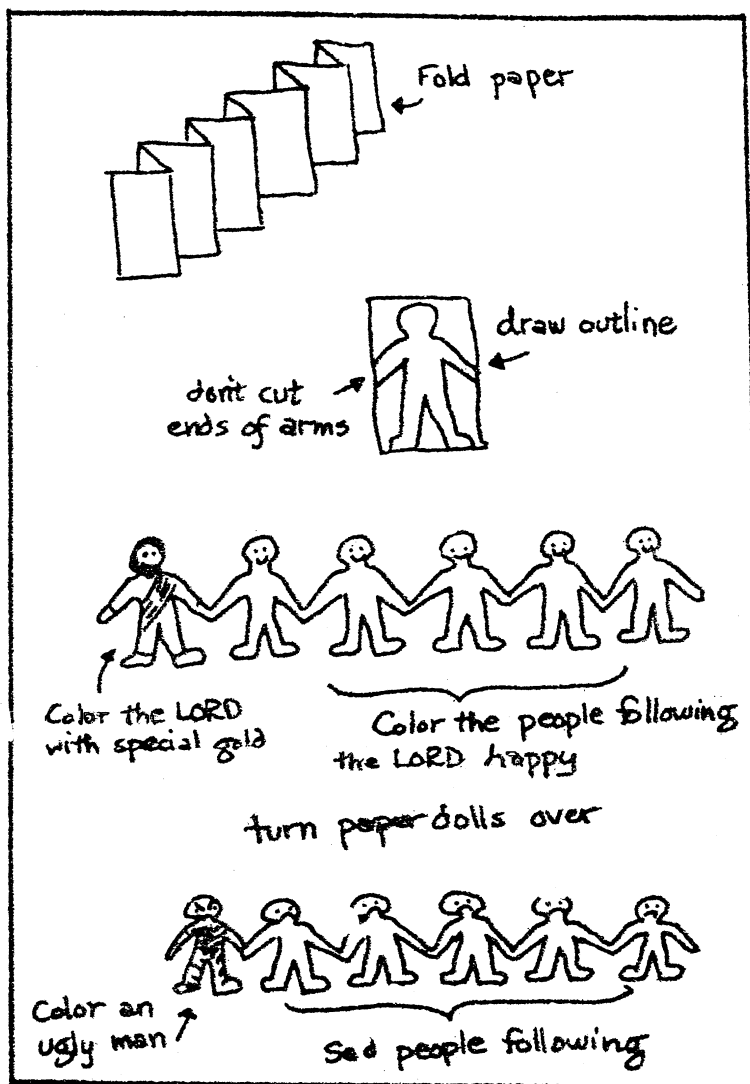
- pencils
- scissors
- gold paint or crayons or glitter & glue
- crayons or markers

teacher preparation:

- make sample
- possibly fold paper and draw outline of person, if either short of time or children are not as adept at projects

procedure:

- fold paper like a fan
- draw simple person on top fold having arms extend off edge
- cut out, not cutting ends of arms
- color the LORD at the front in gold
- color the rest of the people on one side, smiling
- color an evil spirit leading on the other side, at the other end
- color in the rest of the people on that side, afraid and sad
- talk about following the LORD vs. following the world i.e. a king, evil spirits
