Bread and Fish Mobile

This project can help you think about what the Lord gives us to help our minds and bodies grow!

Directions



- 1. Make a copy of the 2 fish and 5 loaves of bread for each child.
- Have children color both sides of the fish and bread with crayons, markers, colored pencils, *etc.* They can also decorate the fish with stickers or glitter, if desired.
 Then sub sub the largest and fish.
- 3. Then cut out the loaves and fish.
- 4. Cut 8 pieces of yarn, making sure they aren't all the same length.
- 5. Cut a rectangular strip of cardboard or cover stock from which to hang the bread and fish (see diagram at left). Or cut out the strip below and mount it on cardboard.
- 6. Tape one piece of the yarn to the top of the quotation strip to hang it from.
- 7. Tape one piece of yarn to each fish and loaf of bread. Then tape these to bottom of the quotation strip. (Adjust the length of the yarn as needed so that the mobile will hang nicely.)
- 8. Hang up the mobile for display.

Note: Older children may want to write quotes from the Word on the loaves of bread and/or fish.
