- a) You might want to point out that the Lord knew things that weren't in His natural vision. He knew that a man would be carrying a pitcher of water. He knew that the owner of the house would willingly let them eat at his house. He knew there was a large upper room for the feast, and that others would not join them, even though the owner had let them use his house.
- b) Then, of course, there is the story of Judas. Jesus knew who would betray Him.

The Lord Eats His Last Supper with the Disciples

And on the first day of unleavened bread, His disciples said to Jesus, “Where shall we go and prepare that You may eat the Passover?” And Jesus sent two of His disciples and said to them, “Go into the city and there you shall meet a man carrying a jug of water. Prepare for us to come there.”

And His disciples went out and came into the city and found a room, just as Jesus had told them. And there they prepared for the Passover.

When it was evening, Jesus came with the twelve disciples. And as they sat and ate, Jesus said to them, “Amen, I say to you, that one of you who is eating with Me shall betray Me.” And they began to be very sad and to say one by one to Jesus, “Is it I?” and another said, “Is it I?” But Jesus answering, said to them, “It is one of you twelve who dips with Me in the dish.”

As they ate, Jesus took the bread and blessed it and broke it in pieces. And He gave it to them saying, “Take, eat; this is My body.”

And taking the cup, He gave thanks and gave it to them, and they all drank from it. And He said to them, “This is My blood of the new covenant, which is shed for many.” Then Jesus said, “Amen, I say to you, I will drink no more from the vine until that day when I drink it new in the kingdom of God.”
