Here are several ways to make a crown of gold stars:

Using Star Garland

1) Fasten 2 yellow or white pipe cleaners together by twisting the ends together. Adjust the size for the person wearing it. Then wrap gold star garland around the pipe cleaners as shown in the picture.

OR

2) Just use the star garland to make the crown.



Using Foil or Paper Stars

3) Cut a strip of yellow cardstock or gold posterboard to make a base for the crown. Glue 12 gold stars (gummed foil stars or cut from yellow or gold paper).

OR

4) Attach the stars to the base of the crown with wire, so that the stars are above the head of the wearer.

One suggestion was that mothers and young daughters might want to wear a crown of stars as part of their celebration of New Church Day while fathers and sons might wear a badge (see Michael's Shield).
