basic supplies:



materials:

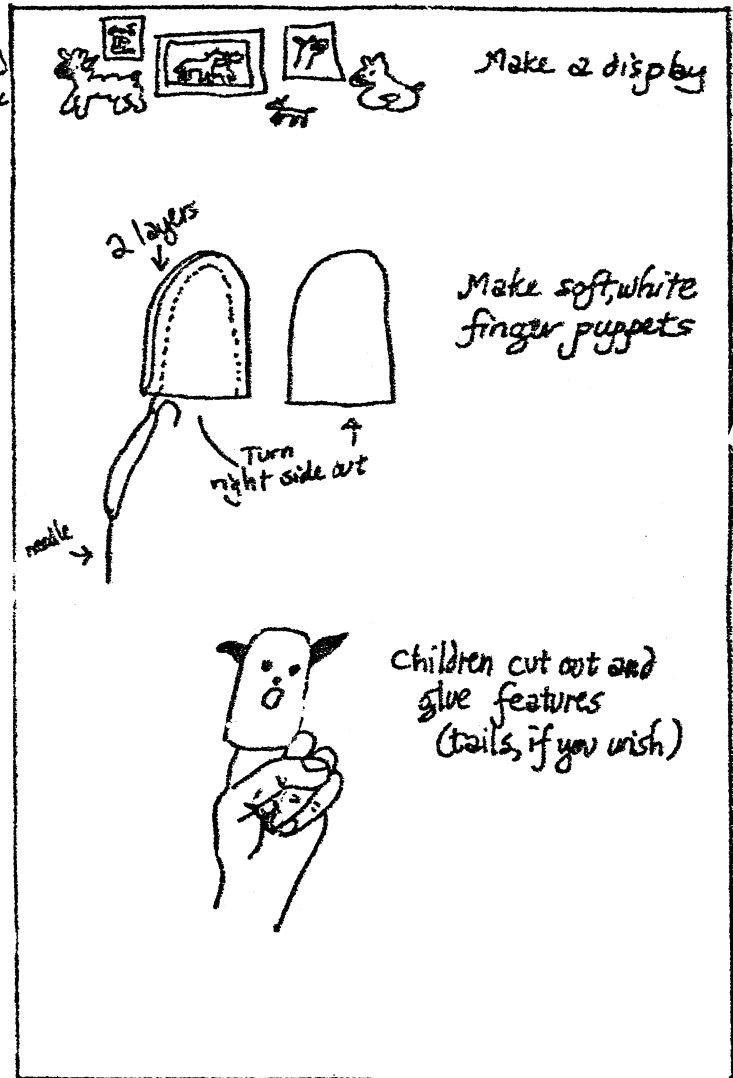
- soft white fabric (felt, wool, terry, flannel...)
- black felt, green & blue felt, red or pink felt
- scissors, glue
- lots of lambs, (pictures, stuffed etc)
- a puppet of a man or king

teacher preparation:

- Make a display of all the lambs you can get, on one wall in the room
- sew white finger-puppets (by hand or by machine) one for each child (or use fingers cut from old white gloves)

procedure:

- Children make puppets into lambs, with felt ears, eyes and tongues
- have them act out the story, v. 1-4, you being the rich man with many flocks, and each child being the poor man with only one little lamb.



notes: They will feel very sad when you take away their lambs — relate that to Uriah. Give the lambs back at the end of the story.
