#### Read

The Lord wants to save every human being. He wants to lift each person from a life of slavery to selfishness, and bring them into heavenly joy. But the Lord wants people to freely choose good or evil. Choosing good involves *seeing* selfish behaviors, *acknowledging* them, and *shunning* them as sins against the Lord.

If the Lord did not allow evil things to happen, people could not be led away from evil.

Unless evils were allowed to break out, a person would not see them and therefore would not acknowledge them, and so could not be induced to resist them. Evils cannot be repressed by any act of providence; for if they were they would remain shut in, and like a disease, such as cancer they would spread and consume everything vital in the person. See *Divine Providence* 251

## **Lead Us Not into Temptation**

This may make it seem as if the Lord wants us to experience temptations. But the truth is that He does not tempt us. He looks constantly at the good that people can be led into by getting rid of their evil actions and longings—which only happens through temptation.

For God never takes part in temptations in any other manner. And though He permits, still it is not according to the idea which a human being has of permission, namely, that by permitting He agrees. A person cannot

understand it in any other manner than that he who permits also wills. But it is really the evil within a person which causes, and leads into temptation. See *Arcana Coelestia* 2768

The Lord views human life from the perspective of eternity.

The Lord foresees and sees all things in both general and particular, and provides and disposes for them. *Arcana Coelestia* 1755

The Lord really wants good things to happen—He *wills* them. He also allows other things that are not quite as good to happen—He *consents* to them. But although He allows bad things to happen He does not will them. He cannot intervene and stop them without taking away human freedom—so He *permits* them.

So although the Lord does not *will* bad things to happen, He allows them so that people can see evil, reject it, and so freely choose heaven.

### Diagram a Temptation Activity

Read the following passages. Complete the activity on p. 3.

Temptation happens when a true idea or a good motivation that is important to a person is attacked by the evil spirits and DEFENDED BY THE ANGELS who are with him. There can be no temptation unless a person loves the truth that he or she knows. Anyone who does not love the true ideas he knows, or is not affected by it, is not troubled about it at all, but anyone who loves the truth worries that the truth might be harmed and lose its power to guide that person (see *Arcana Coelestia* 4274).

During temptation evil spirits **set off a person's false ideas and evil loves**. They **bring out memories** of whatever he or she has thought and done since early childhood. Evil spirits do this so **cleverly** and **wickedly** that it is impossible to describe it. But the angels who are with the person **DRAW OUT GOOD AND TRUE IDEAS** that he has **AND** in this way **DEFEND HIM**. A person experiences this as his <u>conscience tormenting</u> him (see *Arcana Coelestia* 751).

There are two kinds of temptation, the first involves the understanding, the second involves the will. When a person's temptation involves his understanding, evil spirits bring up evil deeds he has done, and use these to accuse and condemn him. They activate his good deeds too, but corrupt them in a thousand ways. At the same time they trigger his thoughts. (see *Arcana Coelestia* 751).

THE LORD GIVES each person TRUE IDEAS and GOOD LOVES. These truths and goods are REMNANTS.... When a person experiences temptations, the angels with him DRAW OUT TRUE IDEAS with which they PROTECT HIM AGAINST THE EVIL SPIRITS who activate false ideas with him (see Arcana Coelestia 737).

Temptations are the means by which the **EVIL LOVES AND FALSE IDEAS** with a person **ARE EXPOSED** and **REMOVED** (*Arcana Coelestia* 5246).

So long as temptation continues, a person thinks that the Lord is absent because he is troubled by evil spirits so severely that he can hardly believe that God exists. Yet THE LORD IS more CLOSELY PRESENT than a person can ever believe. When temptation stops, the person receives consolation and then believes that the Lord is present (see Arcana Coelestia 840).

After temptation **NEW LIGHT** shines forth (see *Arcana Coelestia* 5246).

The things which are from the Lord are either nearer to, or more remote from Him; and they are said to be "from His will," "from good pleasure," "from leave," and "from permission." The things which are from will are most nearly from Him... and those which are from permission are most remotely from Him. These are the degrees of the influx and reception of the Divine. But each degree contains innumerable things which are distinct from those which are in any other degree; and these innumerable things are secrets of heaven, a few only of which fall into the human understanding. Arcana Coelestia 9940

All order begins in the Lord, and it is in accordance with that order that He rules over every single thing. But there is much variation to His rule; that is to say, it may be His Will, or His Good Pleasure, or His Consent, or His Permission from which He rules. Things that have their origin in His will or in His good pleasure are products of laws of order which have regard to what is good, as also do many things that exist by His consent, and even some that do so by His permission. But when a person separates himself from good he subjects himself to the laws of order which are those of truth separated from good and which condemn. For all truth condemns a person and casts him down into hell; but out of mercy, the Lord rescues him and raises him up into heaven. From this it is clear that it is a person himself who condemns himself. Arcana Coelestia 2447





Explore spiritual forces at play during temptation. Read passages from the Writings (p. 2) and note what the angels and evil spirits are doing when a person is tempted. Then put together a diagram showing how the evil spirits and angels affect the person's thinking. Set up a human figure as shown on left, with *Angels* above, *Evil Spirits* below, and what the person is experiencing on the human being.

- 1. The two angels and two evil spirits with us are the source of our thoughts and feelings. The angels inspire true thoughts and good feelings, and the evil spirits inspire false thoughts and bad feelings. We experience conflicts when we know what is right but want to do what is wrong.
- 2. The Writings describe what happens happening in our minds when we experience this kind of conflict. Choose a few passages on p. 2 to read aloud.
- 3. Divide students into three groups. Give each group one color of sticky notes. Groups will copy sets of words onto colored sticky notes. Display as shown.
- 4. **Group 1:** Copy <u>underlined</u> words and stick them *on* the human figure. These words are what the human is thinking.

**Group 2:** Copy **bold** words and stick them *below* the figure. These words show what the evil spirits are doing.

**Group 3:** Copy words in CAPITALS and stick them *above* the figure. These words show what the angels are doing.

#### **Discuss**

- 1. What tactics do evil spirits use to persuade people of their point of view? (e.g. bring up memories of things done wrong in the past and use them to condemn, bring up false ideas, etc.)
- 2. In what ways do the angels defend people against these attacks? (e.g. bring up good and true ideas)
- 3. Why is it hard to detect the hells at work? (act secretly and make people feel as if they are acting from their own free will)
- 4. Can people experience spiritual temptations if they do not care about the Lord and heaven? (no)
