basic supplies:



materials: newspaper, smocks

- orange, red, yellow paint
- leaves (Maple are good)
- paper (blue and colored)
- scissors, glue
- brushes or brayer
- markers (optional)

teacher preparation:

- make sample
- set up place to print (newspapers)
- you can make horse & chariot patterns for children to trace if you like

procedure:

- using brayer or brushes, children paint leaves in fire colors and print on blue paper
- while it dries, they cut out a chariot, horses and Elijah (of colored paper)
- Elisha and the fallen mantle could be included too
- glue chariot, horses and Elijah on top of fire print
- draw scenery with markers if desired
