basic supplies:

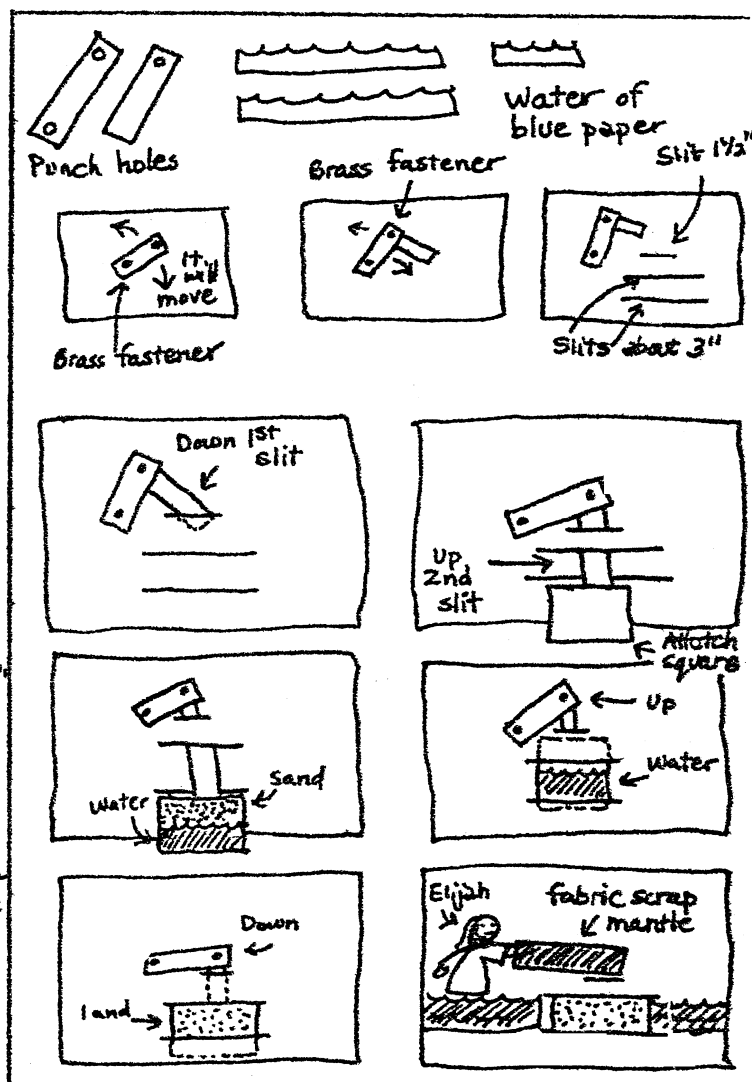


materials:

- fabric scraps
- brass fasteners (2 per child)
- white cardboard (for strips and square)
- blue paper
- white paper
- glue or tape, hole punch, scissors
- markers
- sand

teacher preparation:

- make sample so you really understand how it works



procedure:

- cut a square about 2 1/2"
- cut 2 strips, one about 1" x 3", one 1" x 2"
- punch 2 holes in the long one, one in the short strip
- cut out 3 strips of water; 2 long, 1 short
- put one brass fastener through the long strip, and through the background paper
- put the other brass fastener through the long and short strips
- cut 3 slits in the white paper, such that the short strip will slide through (one short and 2 longer)
- slide short strip down through the 1st, shorter slit, and back up through the 2nd, longer one. Tape or glue the square to the end of the strip
- glue the short water to the bottom half of the square, and sand to the top
- bend and slide square through bottom slit, such that when the long strip is up, the water shows, and when it's down, the land shows
- glue remaining water and fabric mantle
- draw Elijah, and Elisha if desired
