

basic supplies:











materials: newspaper

· stiff paper (light blue or white)
· glue (fast drying ~ Elmers)

colored sand (or other powders like salt, annamin, Sawdust, glitter, green artificial "grass," candy sprinkles etc.)


## teacher preparation:

· make sample

· set up newspapers for sprinkling sand on top of (to catch excess)

## procedure:

- · draw with glue the outline of the river Jordon
- sprinkle blue sand and shake off excess ~ let dry
- put Naaman in the river (no give) and sprinkle with a leprous skin color(salt)
- · with give, draw sun, tand etc. and sprinkle with appropriate colors, shake off excess
- "wash" Naaman 7 times (dump ungleed salt and clothes) and then draw again (with give) and sprinkle with healthy colored skin and clothes (shake off excess)
