basic supplies:



materials: newspaper

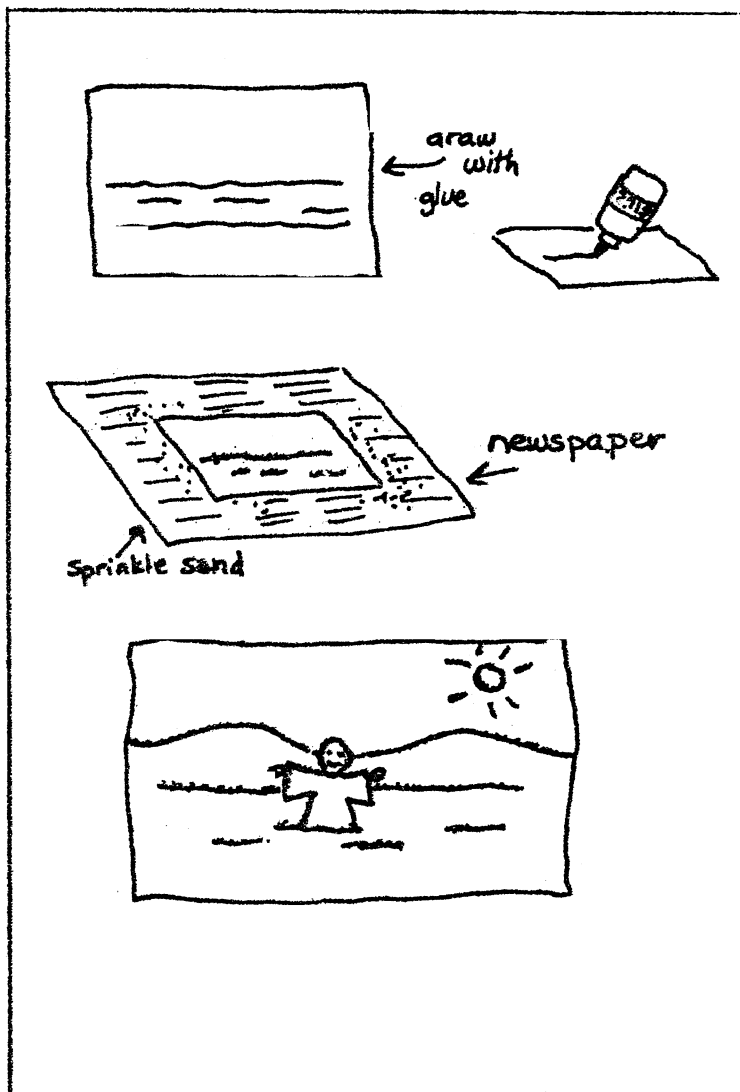
- stiff paper (light blue or white)
- glue (fast drying ~ Elmers)
- colored sand (or other powders like salt, cinnamon, sawdust, glitter, green artificial "grass", candy sprinkles etc.)

teacher preparation:

- make sample
- set up newspapers for sprinkling sand on top of (to catch excess)

procedure:

- draw with glue the outline of the river Jordan
- sprinkle blue sand and shake off excess ~ let dry
- put Naaman in the river (no glue) and sprinkle with a leprous skin color (salt)
- with glue, draw sun, land etc. and sprinkle with appropriate colors, shake off excess
- "wash" Naaman 7 times (dump unglued salt and clothes) and then draw again (with glue) and sprinkle with healthy colored skin and clothes (shake off excess)
