Enter through the Gates


When we do His commandments, the Lord is able to lead us toward the blessed happiness of heaven. For this project you will be able to open the gates to see a picture of the Tree of Life or the Lord.

Materials:

Scissors Markers, colored pencils, or crayons Stapler, tape, or glue

Procedure:

- 1. Cut along the solid lines and then fold the gates at the dotted lines so that they can open and close. (Note: The upper middle area above the gates should be cut out so that you can see what is behind it.)
- 2. On another page, draw a picture of the Tree of Life or the Lord. This picture should be in the center of the page (or glued onto the page) so that it can be seen when you open the gate.
- 3. Put the page with the gate and the quotation from Revelation on top of the page with the Tree of Life (or the Lord) on it. Use glue, tape, or staples to fasten the pages together along the edges.
- 4. Extras: To make this project extra special, let the children use gold metallic markers or glitter to decorate the gate or the Tree of Life.
