

Matching Cards: Food in the Word

These picture cards show six kinds of food that are mentioned in the Lord's Word. The text cards have quotations from some of the places where these foods are mentioned.

Cut all the cards apart along the solid lines, mix them up and then match the pictures with the appropriate quotes. Note that some of the food cards will have more quotations than others. And two of the quotations can be matched with more than one of the food cards!

If you wish, you can find other stories or quotations where these foods are mentioned and make your own additional quote cards. Alternatively, you might think of another type of food that is mentioned in the Word and draw a picture of it on a food card and then make one or two matching quote cards.

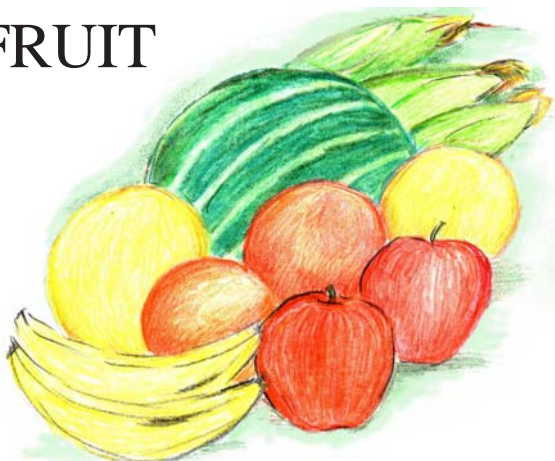
