

This is a picture of the garden of Eden, in which there were all manner of trees and animals, and into which the Lord placed man - Adam and Eve. There were two special trees - the Tree of Life and the Tree of the Knowledge of Good and Evil. Adam could eat freely of every tree, except the tree of the knowledge of good and evil.
