



A Global Perspective on the Church

Make a collage to illustrate the teaching that the church is with all who live in good according to their religious principles.

Suggested Materials

large piece of paper or poster board for background
paper (for drawing pictures of people)
magazines that can be cut up
scissors
glue
pencils, colored markers, wax crayons, *etc.*

Suggested Procedure

1. Collect pictures of people from around the world. It is more important to show people who are doing what is good and useful rather than trying to have people from lots of different regions of the world.
 - a. You could make your own drawings of people from around the world and show them doing good things.
 - b. You could look for pictures of people in magazines and cut them out.
 - c. You may be able to find some photos through clipart on a computer. If you use the Internet to find photos, be careful to note any copyright restrictions.
2. Arrange pictures on a background. This could be a large piece of paper or poster board.
 - a. Optional: To emphasize the idea of the concept of the Lord's church being with people around the world—who are doing what is good according to their religious beliefs—you may want to picture the planet earth or a flat map projection of the world.
3. When you have the pictures arranged the way you want them, glue them onto the background.
4. Then add a quotation such as:

**The Lord's church is with all
in the whole world who live in good.**
