basic supplies:



materials: scissors, glue

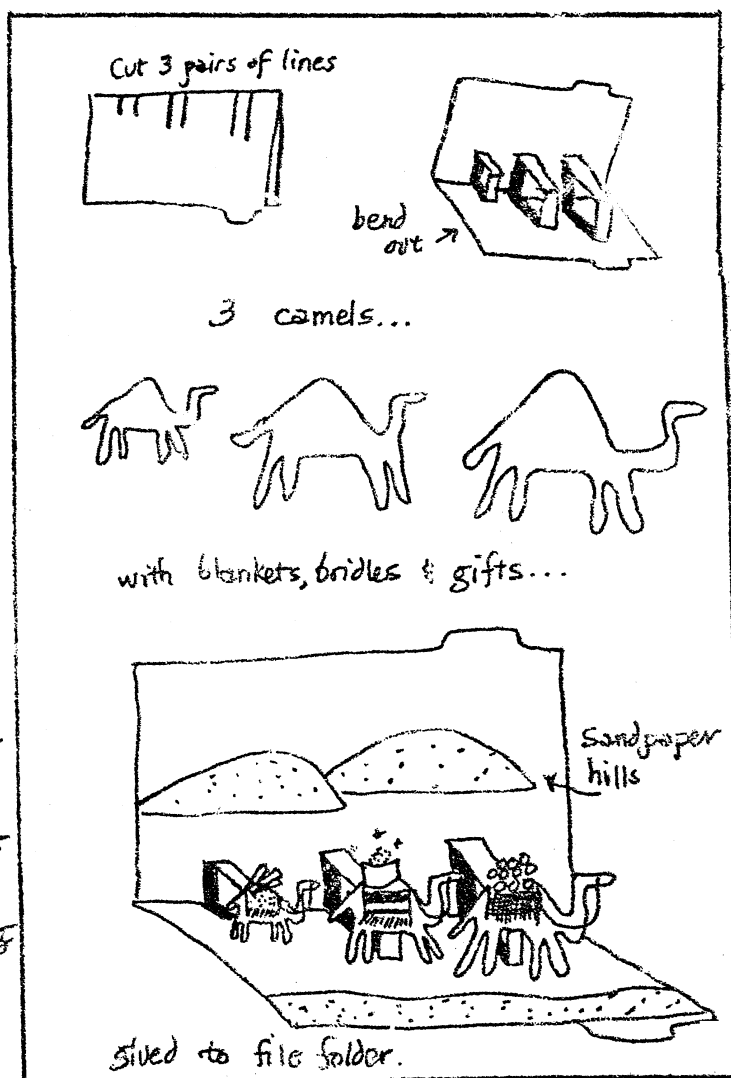
- manilla file folders
- brown construction paper, sandpaper
- wrapping paper scraps (fancy colors)
- gold glitter, sequins, fancy cord or ribbons
- spices (maybe cinnamon sticks, cloves, nutmeg)

teacher preparation:

- Make sample
- Maybe make camel stencils to save time

procedure:

- with file folder folded, cut 3 pairs of lines in increasing length from about $\frac{1}{2}$ " to 2"
- open folder and bend the 3 little corners out so that they are at right angles
- Next cut out 3 brown camels of increasing size from about 1" to 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " long
- Glue fancy blankets and bridles on the camels
- Glue spices, gold and jewels (sequins) to camels' backs
- Glue camels to folded out stands on file folder
- Cut and glue sandpaper hills and/or ground



notes: This is meant to fall near Christmas, so a parallel can be made with the wise men's gifts
