

Easter Greeting Cards

Suggested Materials

construction or heavier weight paper (any color)
 any drawing utensils (crayons, markers, colored pencils, *etc.*)
 pencil and pen (ball point or felt tip)
 eraser

NOTE: If working with a large class, have various sizes of paper cut out ahead of time.

Procedure



1. Fold paper over in half.
2. Write a suitable quotation from the Word inside the card. (See the sample quotations below.)
 Use pencil first. Then go over in pen and erase stray pencil marks.
3. Illustrate the front of the card. See below for suggestions.
