## **Easter Greeting Cards**

## Suggested Materials

construction or heavier weight paper (any color) any drawing utensils (crayons, markers, colored pencils, *etc.*) pencil and pen (ball point or felt tip) eraser

NOTE: If working with a large class, have various sizes of paper cut out ahead of time.

## **Procedure**



- 1. Fold paper over in half.
- 2. Write a suitable quotation from the Word inside the card. (See the sample quotations below.) Use pencil first. Then go over in pen and erase stray pencil marks.
- 3. Illustrate the front of the card. See below for suggestions.
