

Illustrate the Lord as the Vine

"I am the Vine, you are the branches. He who abides in Me, and I in him, bears much fruit; for without Me you can do nothing" (John 15:5).

Make a picture to illustrate this beautiful concept.

- ◆ Picture the Lord near the top or to one side of the page.
- ◆ Show branches of the vine coming from Him.
- ◆ You may also want to show the Sun behind the Lord, sending rays of light (truth) and warmth (love) to help us see ways we can be useful.
- ◆ Write the name of someone you know—a person in your family or a friend—on each of the branches.
- ◆ You may want to draw a large cluster of grapes near the bottom of your picture and write down some of the uses or helpful activities that you do.
- ◆ Write the quotation from John 15:5 somewhere on your picture to help you remember your potential to serve the neighbor as a branch of the vine.
