This project may help you think about heavenly peace by comparing it with natural peace, as is done in *True Christian Religion* 304:

- peace after war, when everyone is safe from enemies and safe in his own home
- recreations of the mind and rest after severe labor
- the joy of mothers who hold a precious gift from the Lord after the effort of childbirth
- serenity after tempests, black clouds and thunders
- spring after a terrible winter, new growth and blossoms in gardens, meadows, and woods
- the state of mind experienced by those who, after storms and dangers on the sea, reach a port and set foot on land

Make a seven page accordion book or a seven part mural that illustrates one of these examples given above.

Illustrate six pictures (one on each panel or page), showing different stages of the dangerous or stressful situation.

In the seventh picture or panel, show the happiness that comes when the danger is passed or the labor is over
