Make a Thanksgiving Plaque

Write the quotation on a plaque (as described below). Then decorate the border.

Materials

wooden plaque
pencil
ruler
permanent marker or metallic pens
colored markers or acrylic paints

Procedure

1. Select a quotation from the Word.
2. Use the ruler and pencil to lightly draw guidelines on the plaque.
3. Write quotation on the guidelines with light pencil strokes.
4. Now write the quotation in your best handwriting—cursive or printing—using permanent marker or metallic pen. Then erase the pencil lines.
5. Decorate the edges with colored markers, acrylic paints, or metallic pens.

Use Calligraphy to Write a Quotation from the Word

Materials

cover stock paper
pencil
ruler
pen or metallic pens
colored markers, colored pencils, crayons or watercolor paints

Procedure

1. Select a quotation from the Word.
2. Use the ruler and pencil to lightly draw guidelines on sheet of cover stock or tagboard.
3. Use light pencil strokes to write the quotation on the guidelines.
4. Now write the quotation in your best handwriting—cursive or printing—using pen or metallic pen. Then erase the pencil lines.
5. Decorate the borders with colored markers, colored pencils, crayons, or watercolor paints.

Illustrate a Quotation from the Word

Select a quote from the Word that has imagery that can be pictured. Illustrate the quotation on the top half of the page. Then write the quotation beneath.
