basic supplies:



materials:

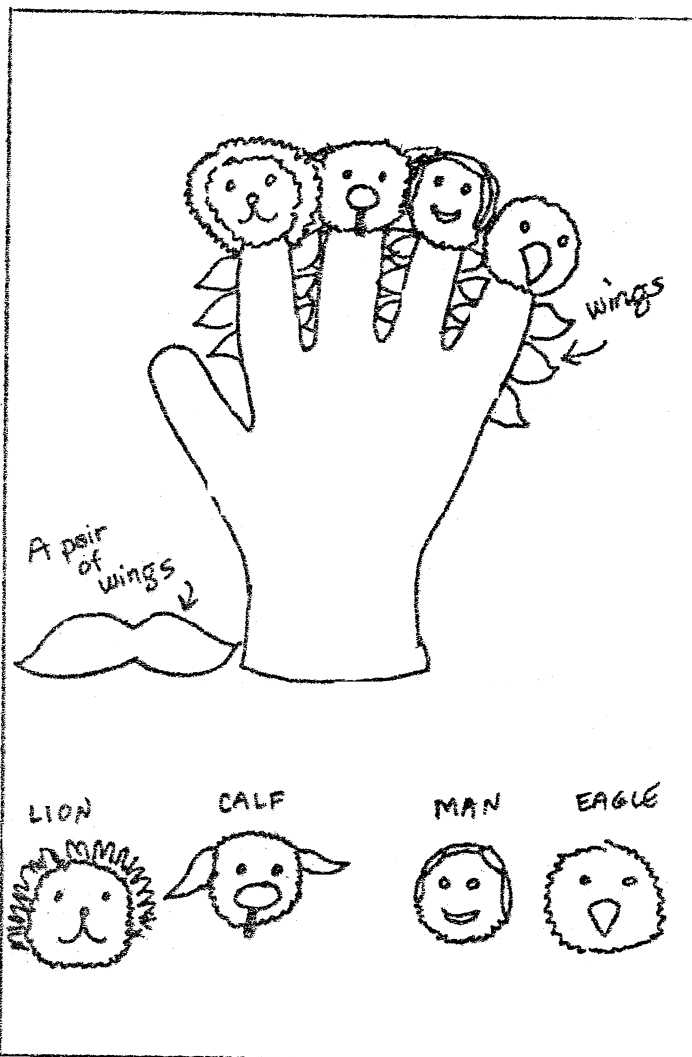
- old gloves, or cheap garden gloves
- 1" or 1 1/2" pom poms (pink, brown, gold or tan, grey or brown)
- felt scraps, glue, scissors
- needles and thread
- yarn scraps

teacher preparation:

- make sample
- you can sew pom poms onto fingers, or let the children do it

procedure:

- sew pom poms on (if not done)
- cut eyes, mouth and hair of felt scraps and glue on pink pom pom for man
- cut beak and eyes of felt and glue on brown pom pom for eagle
- cut mane and eyes & mouth of felt and yarn and glue on gold pom pom for lion
- cut nose, ears, tongue and eyes of felt and glue on grey pom pom for calf
- if you like, cut out 3 pairs of wings for each figure, too



NOTES: one way to make mane is to cut lots of short pieces of yarn and fluff up by rolling in your palms
