Subject: Jonah and the Gourd

basic supplies:      

materials:

- newspaper or newsprint
- brown construction paper
- scissors

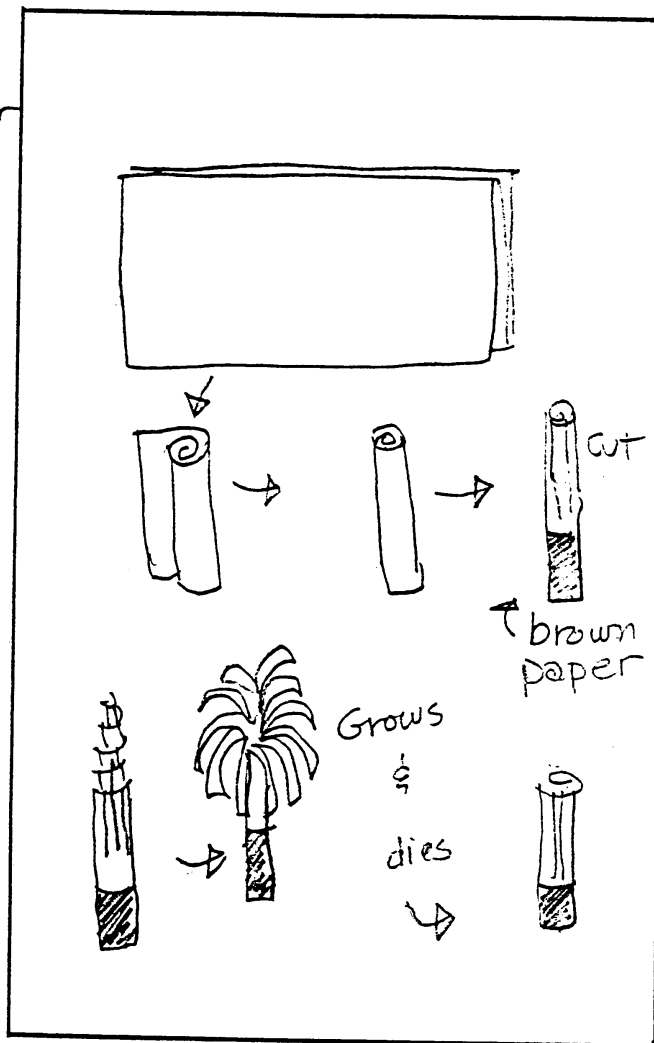
teacher preparation:

- make a practice gourd so you are familiar with what makes a full and attractive plant, and how to make it rise & fall

procedure:

- roll the newsprint (or newspaper) width wise (fat is better than tall) use several sheets
- cut several (the more cuts, the fuller & thinner the leaves) cuts about half way down the roll of newsprint & tape on brown trunk

• while the teacher tells the story of the gourd growing up, children pull the middle of the roll to make it grow, and when the story says to shrivel, push it down
