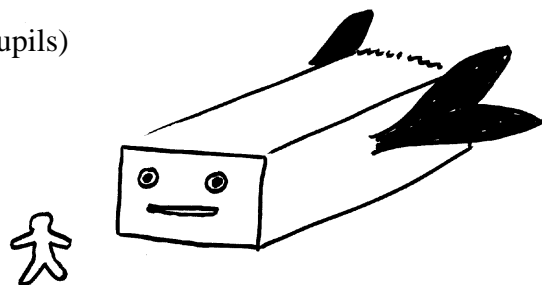


Jonah and the Great Fish

A Paper Bag Puppet

Materials needed for each student:

one paper lunch bag
brown or black construction paper for the tail
white construction paper for the eyes (color the pupils)
card stock to make Jonah
crayons or markers for coloring Jonah
scissors for cutting
glue



Making Jonah

Teacher preparation: Copy the outline drawing of Jonah on to cardstock.

Student activity: The students will color and cut out Jonah. (It will be easier for them to color before they cut—that way there will be less color on the table too!)

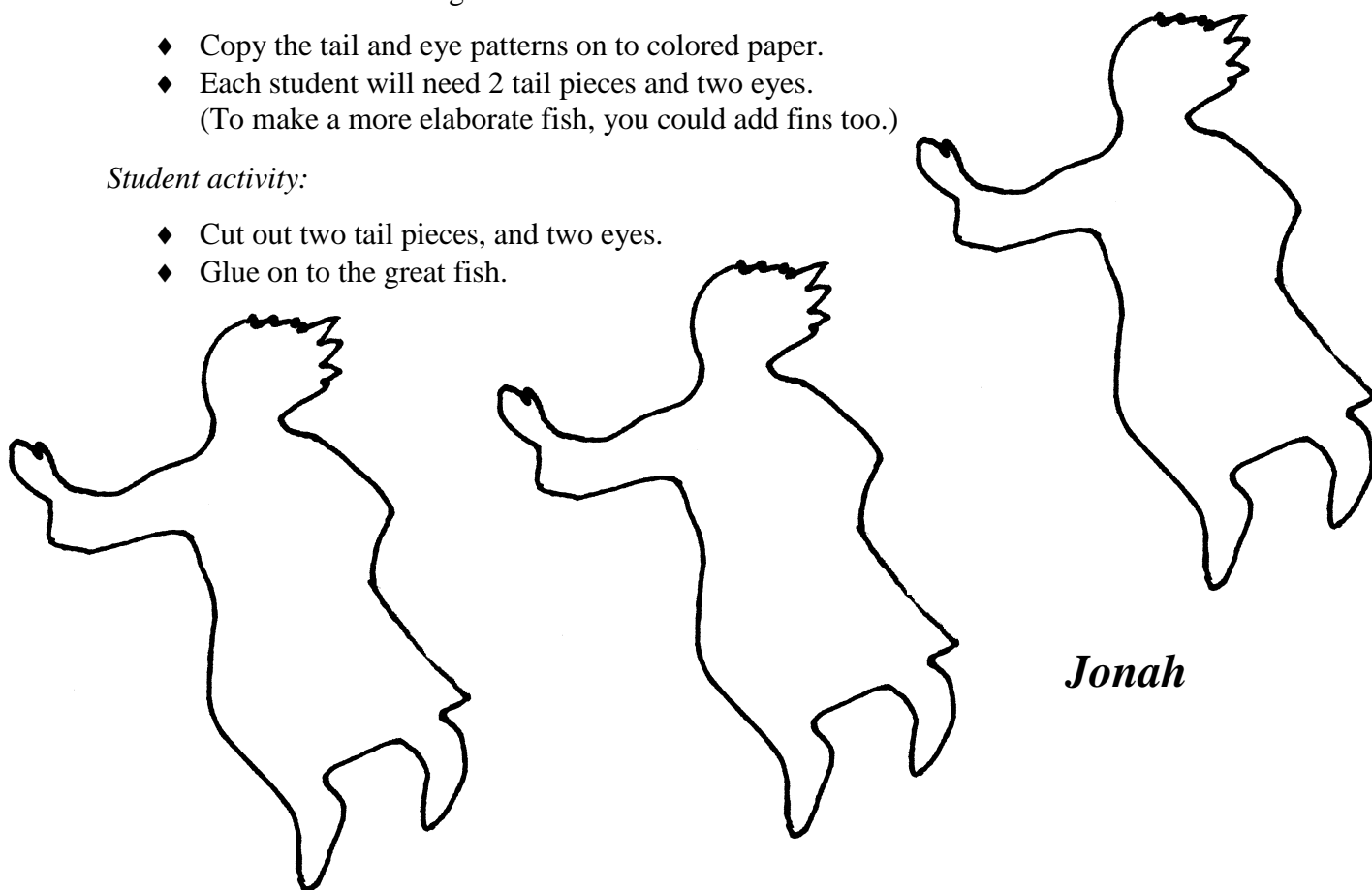
Making the Great Fish

Teacher preparation: It will be easier and safer for the students if the teacher cuts the mouth hole in the bottom of the bag.

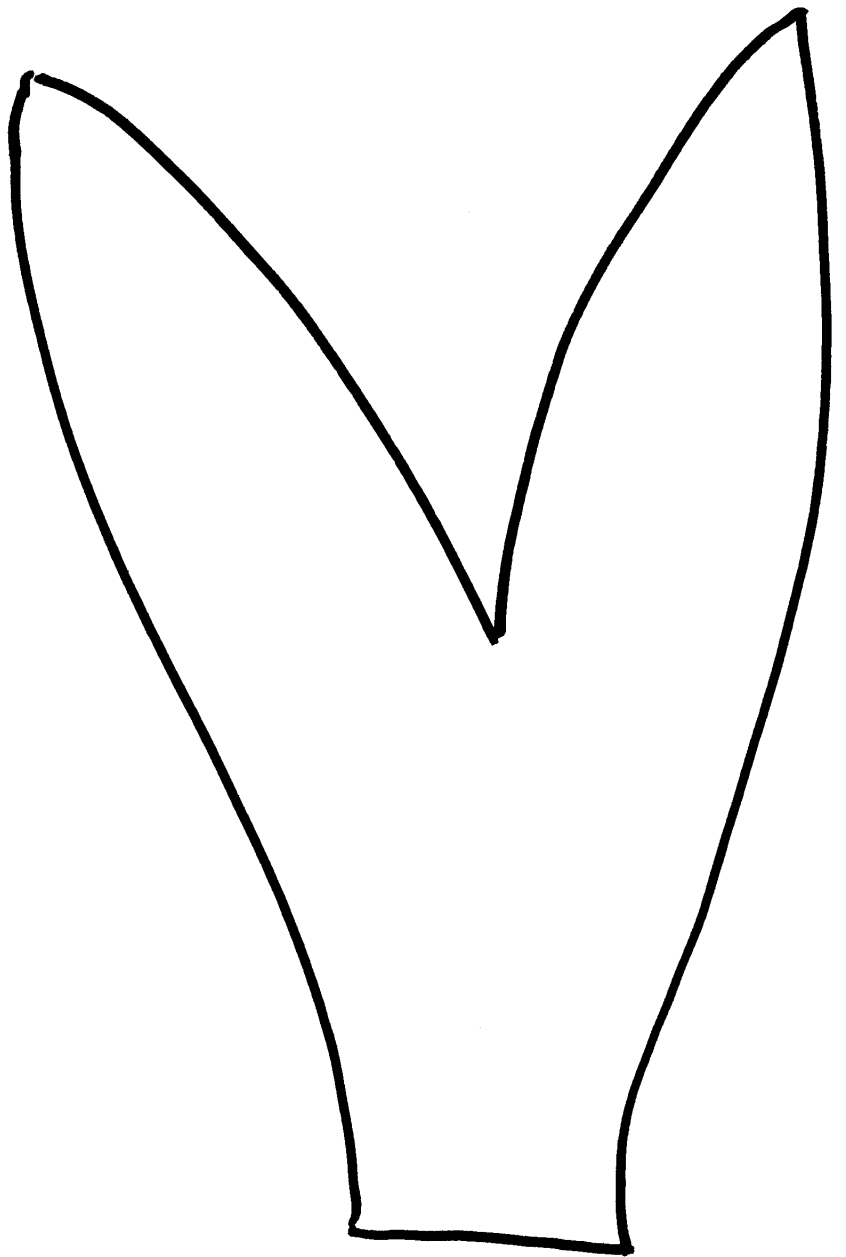
- ◆ Copy the tail and eye patterns on to colored paper.
- ◆ Each student will need 2 tail pieces and two eyes.
(To make a more elaborate fish, you could add fins too.)

Student activity:

- ◆ Cut out two tail pieces, and two eyes.
- ◆ Glue on to the great fish.
