

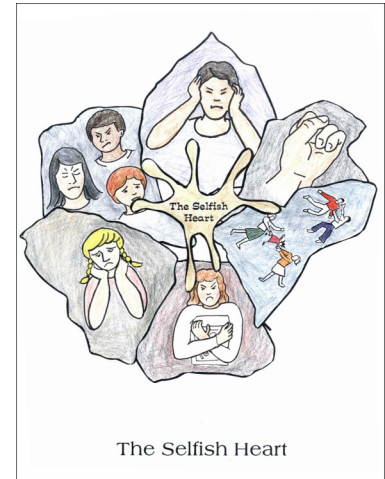
The Kindly Heart or the Selfish Heart

We make up our own selfish or kindly heart by how we behave and what we think. Think about the qualities that make up a kindly heart and a selfish heart. Here are some:



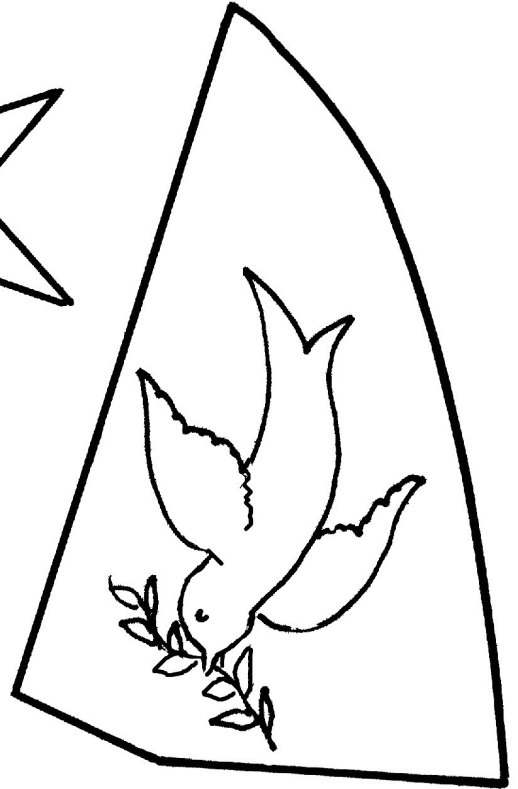
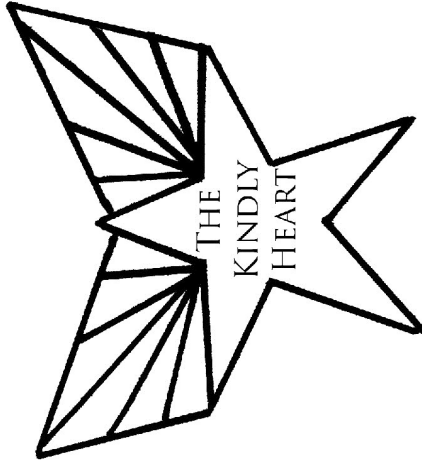
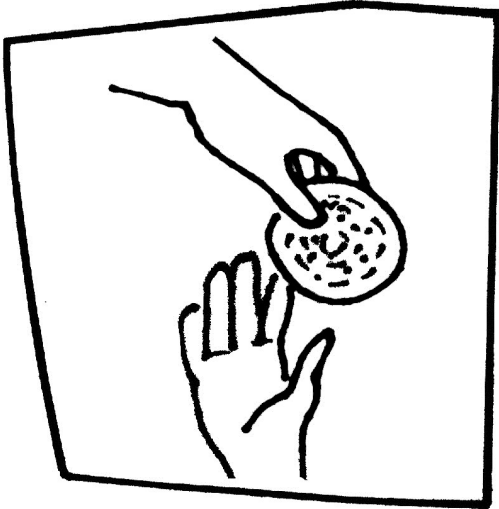

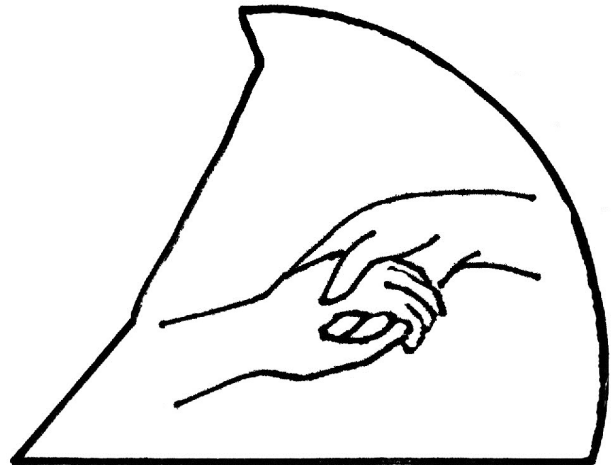
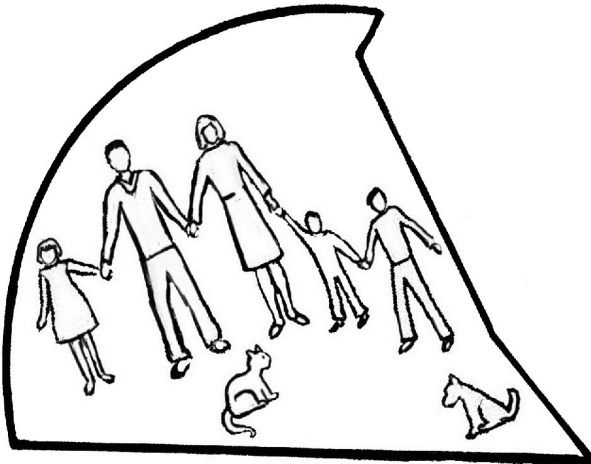
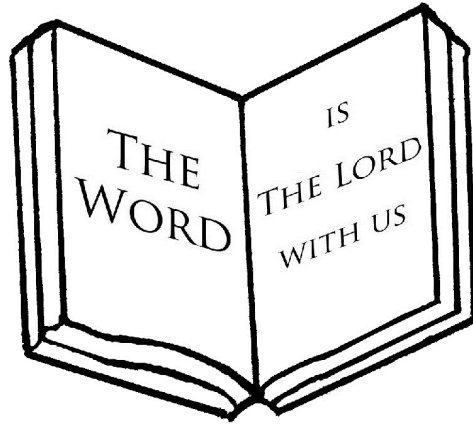
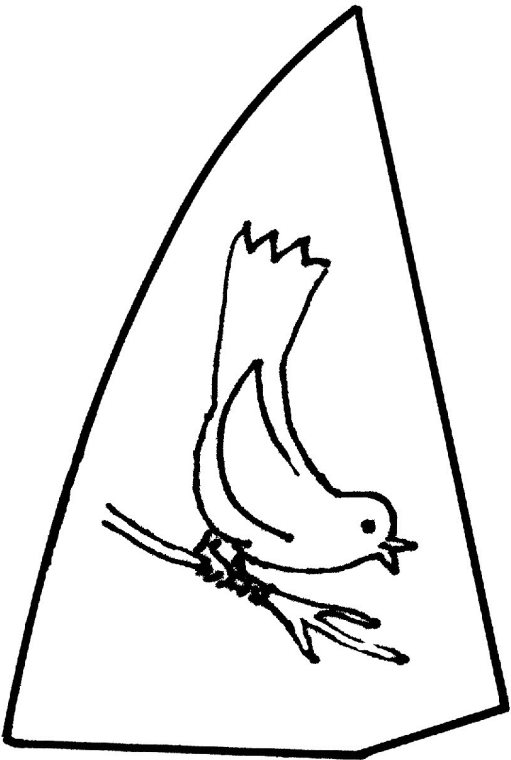


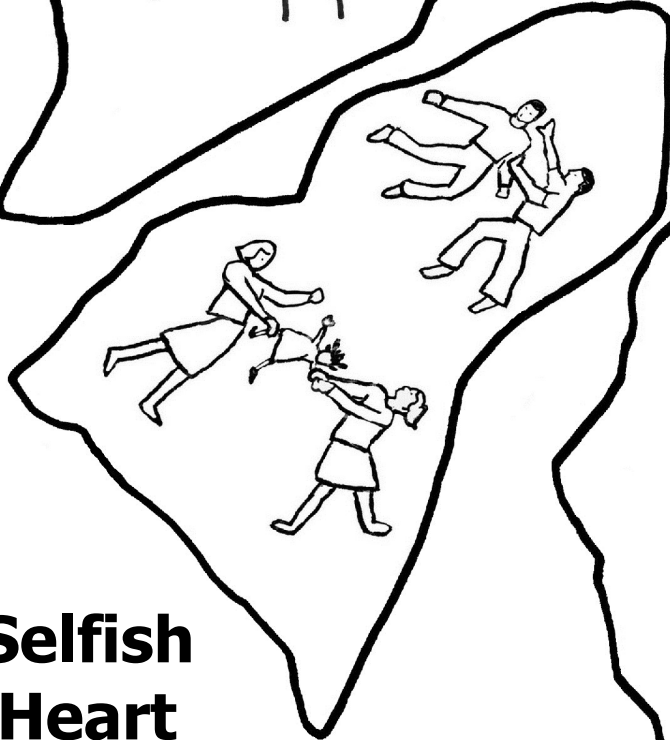
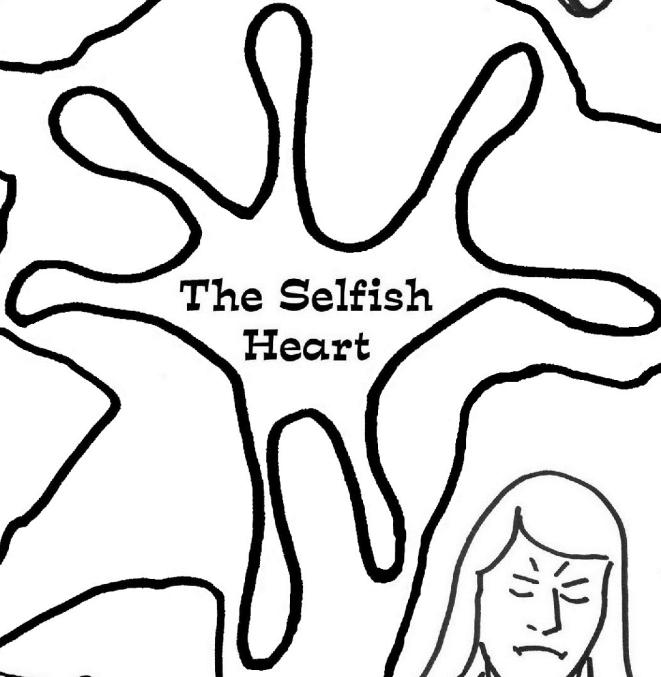
The common thread is that a kindly heart listens to the Lord and His Word. A selfish heart thinks that it has all the answers and doesn't need to listen to anyone. The key to what our own hearts will be like is whether we look to the Lord for guidance and seek to make other people happy or whether we are interested only in our own ideas and wishes.

1. Color and cut out all of the pieces of the kindly and selfish hearts.
2. Assemble the kindly heart, lining the pieces up against the lines on the Kindly Heart page and gluing or taping them down. Use the pictures above as a guide if needed.
3. Match up the selfish pieces with their opposite kindly piece. Place the selfish pieces on the Selfish Heart page and glue or tape them down.
4. Notice that only the kindly pieces fit together smoothly to make a true heart shape!

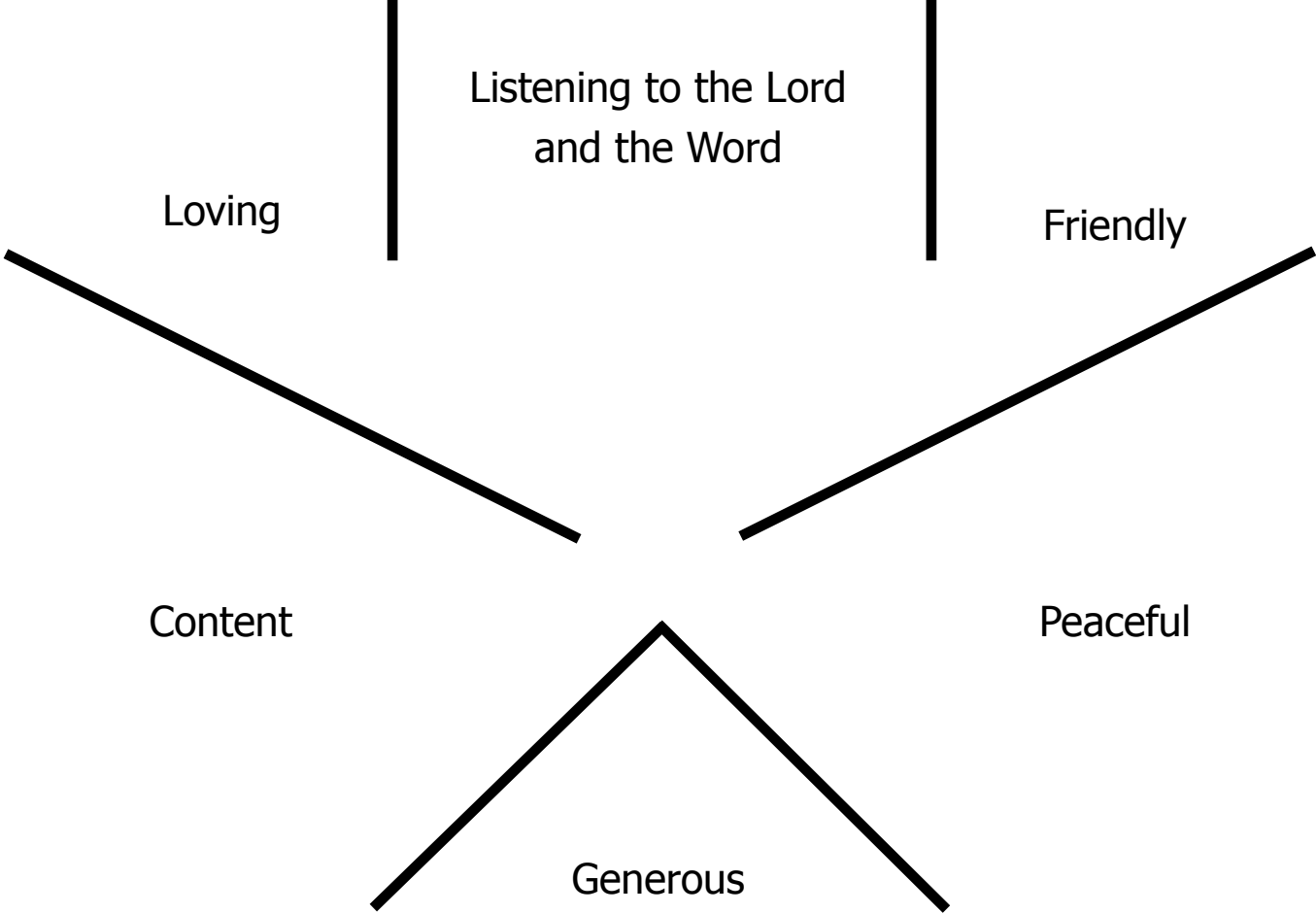


Kindly Heart Pieces

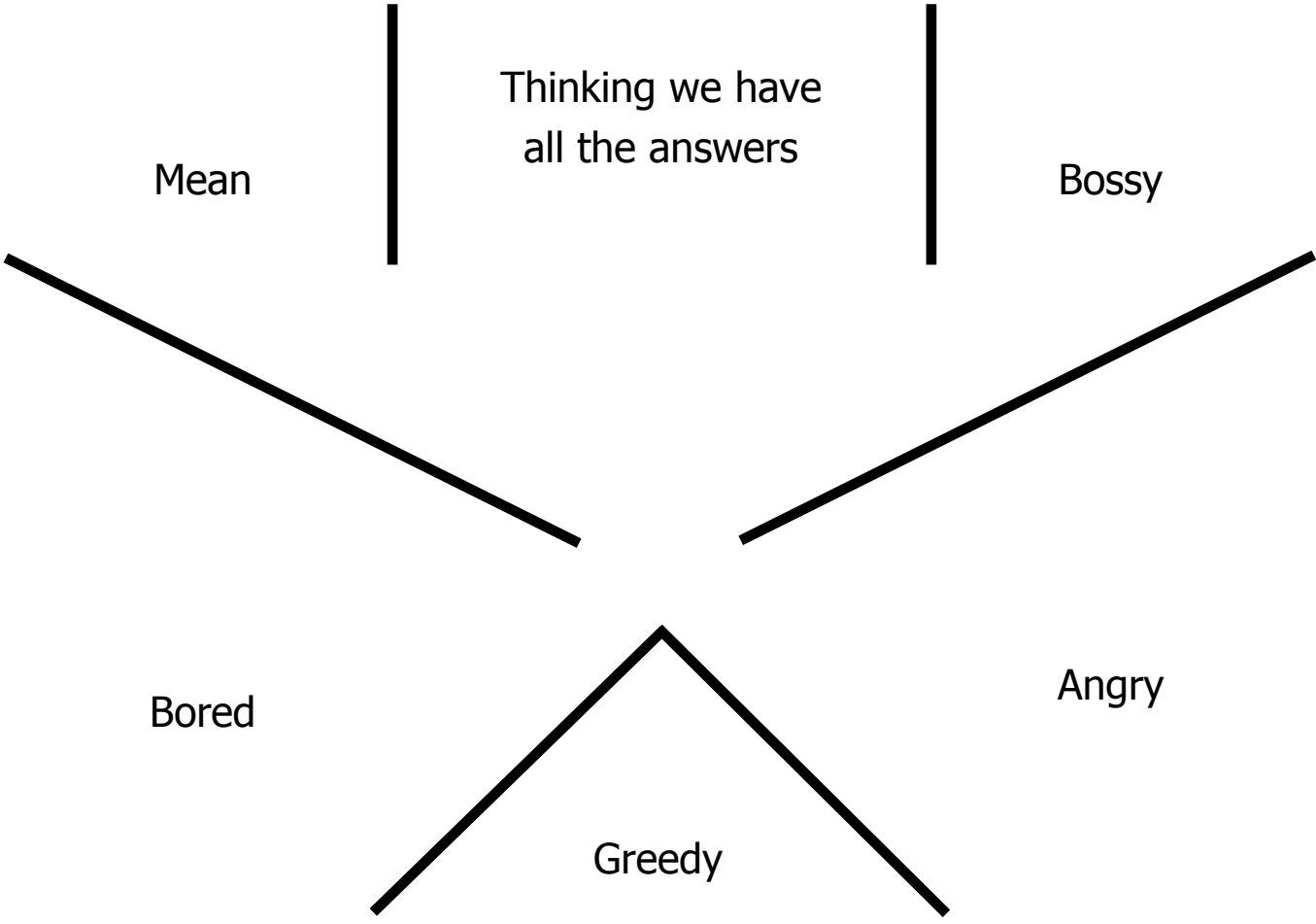
