

## KING DARIUS, DANIEL AND ME

The story of Daniel in the lions' den describes the Lord's protection of Daniel. But it also tells of the Lord's protection of someone else—King Darius. To figure out how the Lord protected King Darius and how this story applies to our own lives, think of a time when you got into a mess because of something you did. Perhaps it was talking back to a teacher, lying to a friend, taking something that belonged to someone else, or letting someone talk you into doing something that wasn't good—just as King Darius did.

Read the story of Daniel in the lions' den in Daniel 6. Then fill in these questions about King Darius, Daniel, and your own life. (The reference numbers show exactly where to look in the Word if you want to check part of the story.)
