

Life in Heaven Accordion Book

How would you picture life in heaven? Let children illustrate one or more aspects of heavenly life and then put them together as an accordion book or a scroll.

Materials

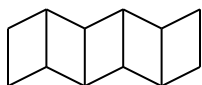
pieces of paper (all the same size)
colored pencils, markers, gel pens, or wax crayons
tape (if making accordion book)

Suggested Illustrations

- baby or little child with angel mother
- little children playing in a beautiful park
- beautiful heavenly sky
- young girl in heaven with her garden
- the open Word
- boys running or playing a ball game
- theatrical performance outside a city in heaven
- the Lord seen in the Heavenly Sun
- an older person waking up in heaven with angels nearby

Procedure

1. Have children illustrate different aspects of life in heaven on separate pieces of paper. See the suggested illustrations for ideas but feel free to illustrate other things in heaven, too.
2. After illustrating scenes of life in heaven, put them in a sequence that you like. You might want to put a picture of the Lord at the beginning or the end of the sequence.
3. Tape the pieces of paper together to make an accordion book as shown below. Then display!

4. *Making a Scroll:* Another option would be to tape the illustrations together vertically so that it hangs down as a scroll. This could be displayed on a bulletin board and then rolled up for storage.
