basic supplies:



materials:

- copy of the WORD
- simple costumes (towels, tablecloths, ropes, fabric remnants...)
- something gold (gold colored box, circles of gold paper like coins etc)
- honey (honeycomb if you have it!)

teacher preparation:

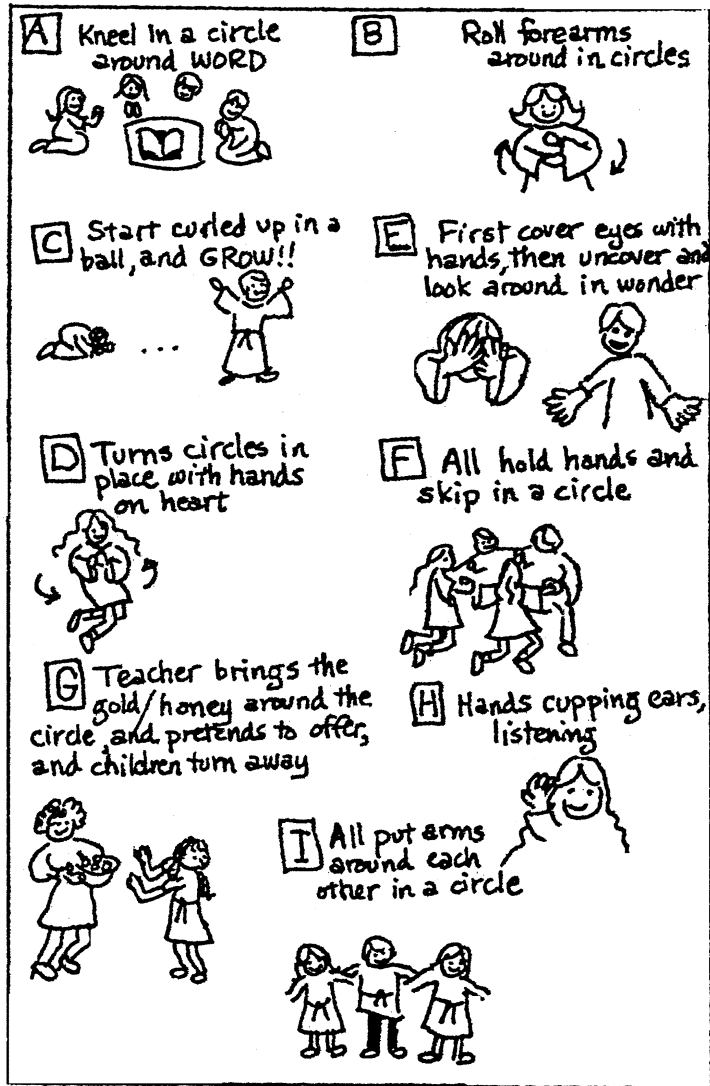
- set up the WORD on a special stand or pillow or piece of velvet in center of the room
- move back furniture to allow room for dance
- learn verses 7-11 by heart
- be sure to explain words like "convert" and "testimony" and "statutes" etc.
