basic supplies:



Materials:


- copy of the WORD
- simple costumes (towels, tableclothes, ropes, fabric remnants...)
- something gold (gold colored box, circles of gold paper like coins etc.)
- honey (Honeycomb if you have it!)

Teacher preparation:

- set up the WORD on a special stand or pillow or piece of velvet in center of the room
- move back furniture to allow room for dance
- learn verses 7-11 by heart
- be sure to explain words like "convert" and "testimony" and "statutes" etc.

procedure: VERSE DANCE STEP

The law of the LORD is perfect, converting the soul;	A
The testimony of the LORD is sure, making wise the simple;	B
The statutes of the LORD are right, rejoicing the heart;	C
The commandment of the LORD is pure, enlightening the eyes;	A
The fear of the LORD is clean, enduring forever;	D
The judgements of the LORD are true } and righteous altogether.	E
More to be desired are they than } gold, yea than much fine gold;	F
Sweeter also than honey and the } honeycomb.	G
Moreover by them Your servant is } warned,	H
And in keeping them there is great } reward.	I
