basic supplies:



materials: newspapers, smocks

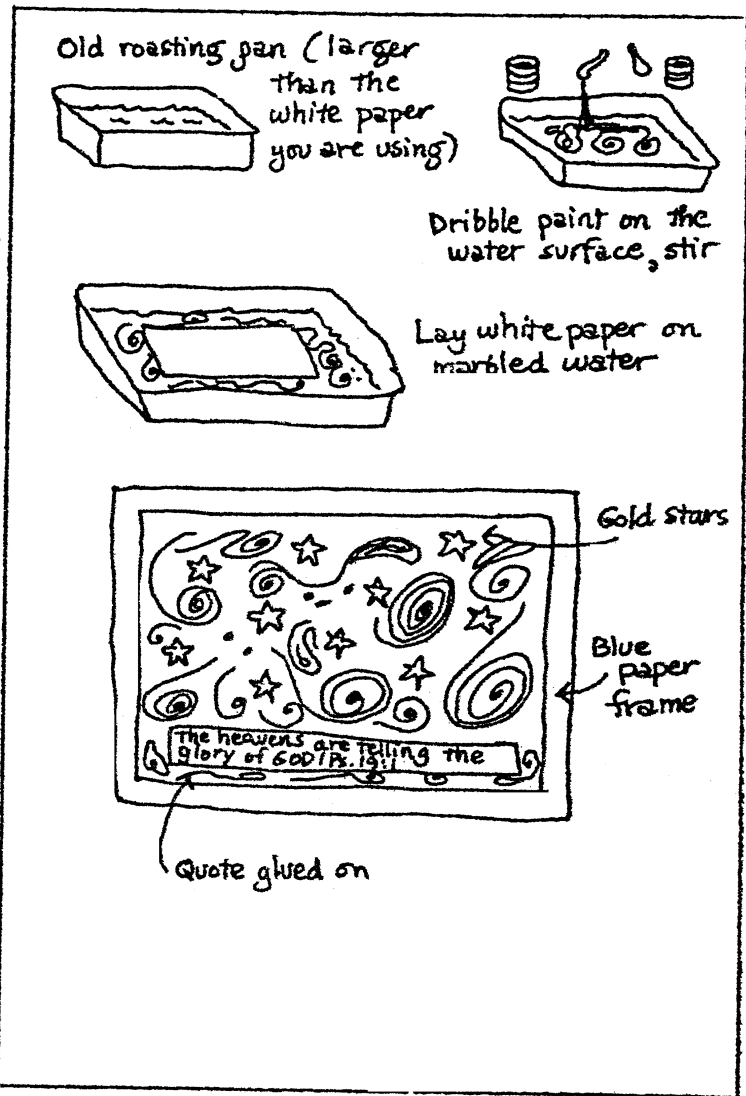
- old or disposable foil roasting pan or other pan about 10" x 14" x 4" \*
- white paper, larger blue paper
- gold stars, markers, glue
- blue and purple enamel paint, rags
- turpentine, water, sticks, plastic spoons

teacher preparation:

- set up a place (outside?) with newspapers and good ventilation for "marbling"
- make sample

procedure: wear smocks

- fill pan with water 1/2 full
- with plastic spoons, dribble blue and purple enamel paint onto water and stir with a stick to desired marbling
- carefully lay white paper on the surface of water to pick up paint
- lay on newspapers to dry (in sun?)
- wipe hands with turpentine on a rag as necessary
- with markers on white paper (small) carefully write out the 1st phrase of Psalm 19
- when dry, stick on (or glue) stars and quote
- mount on blue paper for frame and glue



notes: do marbling 1st and lesson while it dries, then finish project

- \* you can line it with aluminum foil to keep it clean
- if not dry, take home next week
