## **Directions for Making the New Church Day Mobile**

## **Materials:**


1-2 copies of the picture ovals
red, yellow, or white heavy paper such as cover stock or poster board
(OR use a round embroidery hoop)
scissors
tape or staples
ribbon or thread

## **Directions:**

- 1. Print the picture ovals. Note: If you want to have the picture show on both sides of the oval, print 2 sets of the pictures.
- 2. Carefully cut out the picture ovals, cutting along the outside edge of the black oval outline. Set these aside while you make the circle for hanging the pictures.

**NOTE**: Skip steps 3 and 4 if you are using a round embroidery hoop to make the mobile.

- 3. Cut a rectangular piece of heavy paper such as cover stock or poster board. In the sample, the circle was made with an 11 inch by 1.5 inch strip of white cover stock fastened with tape. (If you want a larger circle, use 2 strips of paper taped or stapled together.)
- 4. Place 6 dots evenly spaced around the perimeter of the circle.
- 5. Cut pieces of ribbon or thread. In the sample, the first piece is 6 inches long, the second piece is 9 inches long, *etc*. Each is cut 3 inches longer than the last. This lets the ovals make a spiral as they hang from the circle.



- 6. Arrange the pictures in the order you wish to hang them, saving the picture of the Lord on the white horse to hang above the circle. (In the sample shown above, the order is: holy city, bride, Michael fighting dragon, woman clothed with sun, open Word, John.)
- 7. Attach the first oval to the shortest piece of ribbon with tape. (If you have printed 2 sets of the pictures, tape the two sides of each picture together with the ribbon between them.) Continue around the circle until 6 of the oval pictures are in place.
- 8. Attach 2 or 3 pieces of ribbon to the top edge of the white circle and knot together at the top (see diagram at right). Take a long piece of ribbon and tie it securely to the center of the knotted ribbons.

  Tape the oval picture of the Lord on the white horse just above the knot. Hang the mobile by taping the top of the ribbon to a window frame, door frame, or ceiling.
