

MAKE A PAPER CROWN

The Lord is our King.
(Isaiah 33:22)

Make a beautiful crown to place beside the Word or suspend above it.

Materials:

paper (construction paper or cover stock are ideal)
scissors
glue, tape, or stapler
glitter, colored paper, or markers for decorating the crown

Procedure:

1. Draw the outline of a crown on construction paper or cover stock (see figure A).

2. Decorate the crown with glitter, markers, and/or "gems" cut out of colored paper.
3. Optional: Write a quote from the Word on the crown, perhaps choosing one of the quotes below.
4. Gently bend the paper to make the crown (see figure B) and fasten together with glue, tape, or staples.
5. Put this crown near the Word or use thread to suspend the crown above it.



Quotes from the Word (choose one to write on the crown):

"The Lord is our King" (Isaiah 33:22).
"King of kings and Lord of lords" (Revelation 19:16).
"You are my King" (Psalm 44:4).
"The Lord is King forever and ever" (Psalm 10:16).
