Marriage Mobile

Each of us is touched by a whole series of marriages, going back to our parents and grandparents and working down to our own marriage and that of our children. Picture this with a marriage mobile of a string of hearts made of red paper.

Instructions:

- 1. Make several hearts out of red paper or cardstock.
- 2. Using ribbon, string the hearts together in a column, with a bow or other decoration at the top to hang the column on the wall. On the top heart write the names of your grandfather and grandmother.
- 3. On the next one write the names of your mother and father.
- 4. Then each one below can have the name of one member of your family.

Variations:

If you know more of your ancestors, put more of them above your grandparents.

Note: This could also be done with a friend's family to highlight the idea that each of us has contact with a string or series of marriages.
