

## ***Making the “My Baptism” Book***

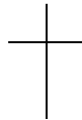
Baptism is a special ceremony of the church. This book can help children learn about baptism while making a book that includes details about their own baptism.

### ***Instructions:***

**Cover** Make a picture or glue a photograph of the child on the day of his baptism (with his parents or the minister).

**“Water” Page** Cut a piece of metallic silver paper (such as aluminum foil) in the outline of a baptismal bowl and glue it to the bottom half of the page.

**“Sign of the Cross” Page** Draw a cross on the page.



**Last Page** This page is for parents to write anything special (or extra) about the child’s baptism.

**Note:** To make it possible for the children to write the missing words with colored markers, we have left large spaces.
